REGIONAL VIRTUAL CAMPUS JOURNALISM WORKSHOP SERIES

1. In view of the Region's commitment and desire to provide quality and relevant education and in support of the goals of R.A. 7079 (Campus Journalism Act of 1991), this Office, through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD) and in partnership with the Regional Association of Elementary School Paper Advisers (RAESPA) and Regional Secondary School Paper Advisers' Association (RSSPAA) and the thirteen Schools Division Offices (SDOs), announces the conduct of the Regional Virtual Campus Journalism Workshop Series on February 7-10, 2023 via Microsoft Teams.

2. The activity aims to realize the following objectives:

- a. enhance the knowledge and skills of school paper advisers (SPAs) on the different journalism categories;
- b. capacitate SPAs to become resource persons on campus journalism in their own divisions or schools;
- c. update SPAs with the new trends in journalism; and
- d. provide a healthy and friendly avenue for SPAs to demonstrate their skills on campus journalism.

3. Each Schools Division shall send six participants (3 English SPAs and 3 Filipino SPAs) from private and/or public schools per category so that there will be a total of 102 participants which will be reflected in the Division Confirmation Sheet (Enclosure A) and submitted to the Regional Office thru clmd.region8@deped.gov.ph not later than February 6, 2023. Each participant, moreover, is allowed to join only one category to ensure that more SPAs from the same Division will be able to participate. However, each Division Campus Journalism Coordinator may join any session to monitor the participation of the SPAs from the Division.



4. The workshop shall have seventeen topics or categories and shall be conducted following different schedules:



6. The training teams shall lead; create and share the link via the Supervisors' Chat Group; and host the conduct of the topic assigned to them. They are also reminded to check their gadgets and consider some contingency measures to lessen the impact of unforeseen events such as power outage or weak internet signal during the conduct of the activity.
7. The Schools Division Superintendents shall also ensure the complete participation of their identified SPAs in their assigned categories.
