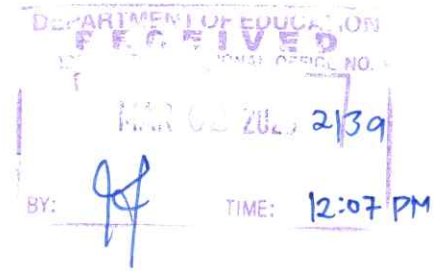

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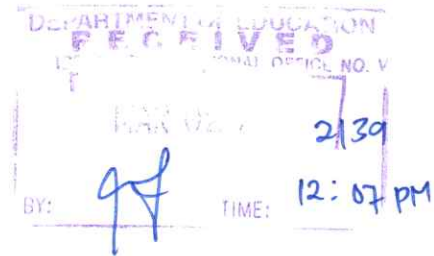

### III. Overview:

The Philippine Floorball Association (PFA) as the sole governing body of the sport Floorball in the Philippines aims to be the largest sport movement with active membership in the country. With this, the PFA Education and Club Development Committee is highly motivated to provide opportunities for the youth, PE teachers, sports leaders and enthusiasts to be part of the *Pilipinas Floorball Movement*. The primary goal of this program is to promote active physical activity to all using Floorball as the platform and to empower PE teachers, sports leaders and sports enthusiasts to be active contributors for the growth and development of Floorball in the country.

The first program is the *Floorball Demonstration* (Program A) that will primarily focus on giving a quick (3 hours) but meaningful experience to the participants to learn the fundamental skills in playing Floorball. The second program is the *PFA Floorball Educator Course* (Program B) that aims to empower the participants in acquiring fundamental knowledge and skills in coaching Floorball. The graduates of this course will be recognized as lifetime PFA Floorball Educators. The course will serve as an entry point for Floorball coaching certifications both national and international level. In order to accomplish the course, the participant must complete the entire program by performing the necessary activities, passing the written exam and submitting the required outputs. In addition, this project is in partnership with 1PhysEd.Ph Training and Development Services to provide Continuing Professional Development Points (CPD Points) to Licensed Professional Teachers that they can use upon renewal of the teaching license.

Through this activity, PFA plans to have regional Floorball associations that will lead different programs and events for the promotion of the sport.

### IV. Main Objective:

#### Program A: Floorball Demo

To promote health and physical activity in different communities using Floorball as a medium.

#### Program B: Floorball Educator Course

To empower PE teachers, sports leaders and sports enthusiasts to be active contributors for the growth and development of the Floorball in the country.

## **V. Specific Objectives:**

### **Program A: Floorball Demo**

**At the end of the course the participants are expected to:**

- a. be familiarized with the fundamental skills in playing floorball;
- b. participate in actual floorball game; and
- c. realize the important role of active engagement in physical activity as a tool to promote health.

### **Program B: Floorball Educator Course**

**At the end of the course the participants are expected to:**

- a. to be familiarized with the mandate, programs, activities and opportunities in the Philippine Floorball Association;
- b. to gain understanding with the fundamental concepts, rules of the game, skills and competencies in teaching Floorball in club or PE setup;
- c. to perform accordingly the necessary skills in playing and teaching Floorball;
- d. to create a program/lesson in teaching Floorball;
- e. to gain confidence to perform different fundamental skills in the sport such as: ball handling, passing, receiving, shooting, fundamental tactical skills for offense and defense; and
- f. to be part of the Pilipinas Floorball Movement as representative of their respective area.


