**DOWNLOADING OF A PORTION OF THE ALTERNATIVE LEARNING
SYSTEM PROGRAM SUPPORT FUNDS IN FISCAL YEAR
2023 TO THE SCHOOLS DIVISION OFFICES
AND SELECT SCHOOLS**

To: Schools Division Superintendents
Regional Division Chiefs
All Others Concerned

1. To continually support to the National Alternative Learning System - Education Skills Training (ALS-EST) Pilot Implementation, as one of the concerns in the discussion with Hon. Assistant Secretary G.H. S. Ambat after the adjournment of the 5th Project Steering Committee Meeting of the Project *Better Life for Out-of-School Girls to Fight against Poverty and Injustice in the Philippines* on November 4, 2022 in Makati City, Manila, and to provide financial support to the operations at the Schools Division Offices (SDOs) and to the select pilot schools implementing the ALS Senior High School (SHS) and ALS in School-Based Management (SBM) in addressing the relevant challenges encountered as observed during the onsite monitoring in the first quarter of the Fiscal Year 2023, this Office, through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD) and Finance Division (FD), shall download funds amounting to Four Million Fifty-Five Thousand Six Hundred Pesos (**Php4,055,600.00**) from the 2023 Program Support Funds for the ALS through a Sub-ARO to the recipient offices based from the breakdown and corresponding purposes presented in the enclosure.
2. The Schools Division Superintendents, through the respective Chiefs of the Curriculum Implementation Division, shall submit financial reports on the utilization of the downloaded funds on or before December 31, 2023 to clmd.region8@deped.gov.ph cc alfredo.cafe@deped.gov.ph.
3. Further, there shall be a regional monitoring and technical assistance provision during the School Year 2023-2024, through any authorized modality, to check the status of the utilization of the downloaded funds intended for the ALS Program implementation while enhancing the absorptive capacity of the Schools Division Offices and of the recipient schools, chargeable against the downloaded Program Support Funds for the ALS.

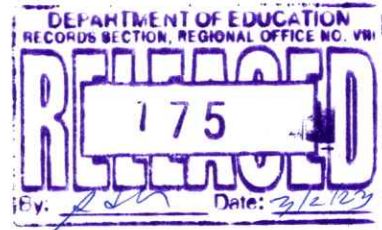
