**INVITATION TO JOIN AN ART COMPETITION IN CELEBRATION
OF THE 75TH ANNIVERSARY OF DIPLOMATIC RELATIONS
BETWEEN EGYPT AND THE PHILIPPINES**

1. Pursuant to DepEd Memorandum, DM-CT-2023-018, dated February 28, 2023 re: Invitation to Join an Art Competition in Celebration of the 75th Anniversary of Diplomatic Relations Between Egypt and the Philippines, with the theme “Egypt in the Eyes of the Filipino Children,” this Office, through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD), shall conduct a Regional Arts Contest relative to the aforesaid activity on June 23, 2023.
2. The activity aims to showcase the talents in painting of elementary learners as they reflect the depth of their knowledge and understanding of the diplomatic relations between Philippines and Egypt through their artwork.
3. The details on the schedule and mechanics of the said regional contest are as follows:
 1. The Regional Arts Contest with the theme “**Egypt in the Eyes of the Filipino Children**”, shall be held on June 23, 2023.
 2. The contest is open to all private and public elementary learners which shall consists of two categories-Grades 1-3 and Grades 4-6.
 3. There shall be only one (1) entry for each category for each division.
 4. All entries/paintings shall be on illustration board with 15 X 20 inches, using either oil pastel or crayon.
 5. All entries for the whole duration of the actual painting shall be recorded and shall be emailed at clmd.region8@deped.gov.ph and nova.jorge@deped.gov.ph on or before June 19, 2023.
 6. The division entries shall indicate the following information in their recorded video output:
 - a. Title of the Painting
 - b. Full Name, Age, Grade Level, School, Division, and Address of the Artist
 - c. Brief Description of the Painting in Tagalog or English
 7. The top one (1) for each category shall represent DepEd Region VIII to the Art Competition in Celebration of the 75th Anniversary of Diplomatic Relations Between Egypt and the Philippines which shall be submitted on or before July 7, 2023.



8. The SDO/s with the winning entries shall be in-charged in sending the paintings to the address stipulated below:

9. Expenses incurred relative to the said Regional Contest including the shipping of the winning entries to the national level shall be charged against local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
10. All regional winners will receive Certificate of Recognition while the non-winners including the school will be given Certificate of Participation.
11. The criteria for judging are as follows:
 - 35%- Relevance to the theme;
 - 30%- Originality;
 - 25%- Creativity and presentation; and
 - 10%- Over-all impact

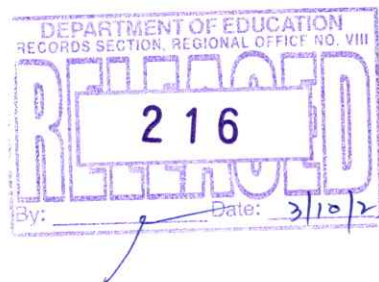

Contest Mechanics:

1. Entries should follow the theme, "Egypt in the Eyes of the Filipino Children".
2. All entries/paintings shall be on illustration board (15 x 20 inches), using either oil pastel or crayon.
3. The contest is open to all public and private elementary students.
4. There are two (2) categories:
Category A: Grades 1-3
Category B: Grades 4-6
** Two (2) students may collaborate and work together on one (1) entry provided that they belong to the same school and grade level.
5. Each DepEd Regional Office should submit one (1) entry for each category to the Bureau of Learning Delivery (BLD) on or before July 7, 2023 for final judging.
6. Winning entries shall become the property of the Embassy of the Arab Republic of Egypt while non-winning entries shall be the property of the event organizer should it not be claimed in 90 days after awarding ceremonies.
7. The winners (per category) will receive a crystal trophy and the following cash prizes:

1st Runner-up	Php 30,000.00	Php 40,000.00
2nd Runner-up	Php 15,000.00	Php 20,000.00

8. Prizes shall be provided and covered by the Embassy of the Arab Republic of Egypt.
9. The schedule of the Awarding Ceremony shall be on July 20, 2023 and the venue shall be announced through an Advisory.
