

EVALUATION AND RECOMMENDATION REPORT OF SCHOOL'S APPLICATION

CONVERSION OF SAN PABLO ELEMENTARY SCHOOL TO SAN PABLO INTEGRATED SCHOOL, BRGY. SAN PABLO, HINUNANGAN, SOUTHERN LEYTE

BACKGROUND

The universal declaration of Human Rights recognizes education as a fundamental right necessary for the growth of an individual and development of society. However, some of these youth are denied of this right because of poverty and inequitable access to secondary schools.

The tiny twin islands of San Pablo and San Pedro can be found along the coastline of the municipality of Hinunangan, Province of Southern Leyte. The Barangay Profile Report illustrates that farming and fishing are the main sources of income among barangay folks. Both shared a considerable number of school-aged children who are at risk of traveling by boat to the nearest junior high school, which is 5 kilometers away. As a result, most of the learners opted to stay in boarding houses in the mainland at the early age of 12-13. Thus, making the learners vulnerable to peer influence and sexual abuse.

The socio-economic condition, distance and mode of travel in going to a secondary school hinder these children to maximize their potential and contribute in uplifting their family's way of living through education.

To solve this urgent need to establish a secondary school, a thorough evaluation of the possibility of converting an elementary school to an integrated one. Since San Pablo Elementary School has an excess of seven classrooms the Barangay officials of both islands executed a joint resolution endorsing the conversion of San Pablo Elementary School to San Pablo Integrated School to cater the secondary school-aged learners in the islands.

In view thereof, the local government unit of Hinunangan represented by Local Chief Executive Engr. Reynaldo C. Fernandez expressed their strong desire for the conversion of San Pablo Elementary School to San Pablo Integrated School to lessen the financial burden of the parents and make certain on the safety of the learners.

Moreover, the Schools Division of Southern Leyte extremely expressed his support to the proposed conversion of the school initiated by the concerned parents

and local officials to give equal opportunity to all school children to access secondary education within the island.

In response to the school's application, the Regional Inspectorate Team (RIT) conducted an ocular inspection to validate the school's readiness subject to recommendation and appropriate action of the Regional Director. The following are the findings and recommendations of the ocular inspection conducted:

FINDINGS:

- San Pablo Elementary School is offering multi-grade classes from Kindergarten to Grade 6.
- The school has 7 vacant standard classrooms in a two-story school building.
- The school has 3 teachers and a TIC who is qualified to manage the operation of an integrated school.
- The school site has no defined boundaries to show the bounds of the property.

RECOMMENDATIONS:


In view of the foregoing validation, the team respectfully recommends that:

- The school shall be named SAN PABLO INTEGRATED SCHOOL, is authorized to continue its operation effective School Year 2023-2024.
- The school shall implement K-12 Basic Education Curriculum.
- 4. School operation shall be on a gradual basis. Thus, curriculum grades to be offered upon opening of classes for SY 2023-2024 shall be Grade 7 which may progress to the next grade levels in the succeeding years.
- The Local Government Units both Barangay and Municipal together with the parents shall provide financial support to the school until such time that operations will be covered by the DepEd.
- 6. The Schools Division Superintendent shall provide teachers trained in the K to 12 Curriculum, consider additional teachers to this school and monitor the operation of **SAN PABLO INTEGRATED SCHOOL.**
