

The FSL Curriculum has been implemented since SY 2020-2021 by pilot teachers of the deaf in the three project sites and we have gathered their **First Feedback** on July 2021. The final report on this is in **Annex** 1.

We have prepared the Second Feedback Sheet (Annex 2) which shall be accomplished by these pilot teachers of the deaf who continued to use the FSL curriculum. As reference for this, we have provided the Second Version of the FSL Curriculum in Annex 3. The

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names of the pilot teachers and schools are indicated in Annex 4. May we appeal to them to submit their responses through this Feedback Sheet on or before April 14, 2023.
