The activity aims to:

1. promote the district discipline of geography amongst Filipino youth;
2. develop geographic literacy and social awareness through mapping;
3. exhibit how mapping can instill a narrative; and
4. encourage participation amongst high school students.

The target participants are high school students from Grades 9 to 12 from public and private schools.

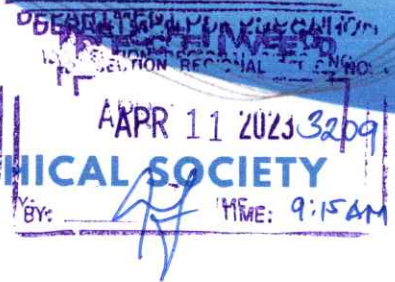
