



 - a. Batch 2 participants are Regions VI, VII, VIII, IX, X, XI, XII, Caraga, and BARMM.
 - b. Participants are expected to arrive at 12:00 noon of August 7, 2023, and may proceed in the designated Conference Hall upon arrival at the venue. The opening program will begin at 2:00 pm.
