- Dr. Amenia C. Aspa - EPS

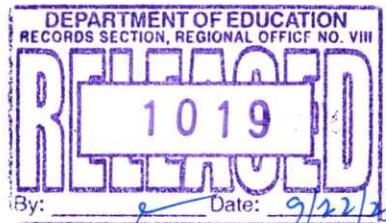

The said event will be held **on September 26-27, 2023 (Tuesday to Wednesday) at the Luxent Hotel, Quezon City, Metro Manila.**

In this regard, this Office enjoins the Regional Offices to each send two (2) participants, and for the Bureau of Curriculum Development to delegate six (6) participants, to the said event. To maximize the gains from the event, the said participants are recommended to be those involved in the Peace Education Integration in your respective areas of jurisdiction.

For the regional participants, the following will be shouldered by OPAPRU:

1. Airfare Provision (airport of origin to Manila and vice-versa);
 - a. **Kindly note that sea travel and land transportation cost from NAIA to the venue and vice-versa shall NOT be provided.**
2. Hotel Accommodation from September 25-28 2023 (Monday to Thursday);
and

3. Meals

- a. Dinner upon arrival to the hotel on September 25 2023 (Monday);
- b. Full board meals on September 26-27, 2023 (Tuesday to Wednesday);
and
- c. Breakfast on September 28, 2023 (Thursday).

On the other hand, expenses incurred by the participants from the Bureau of Curriculum Development shall be charged to their respective Central Office fund, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
