

CRITERIA FOR JUDGING:

CRITERIA	DESCRIPTION	PERCENTAGE
Theme Relevance	Assess how well the poster aligns with the theme of National Crime Prevention Month. Does it effectively communicate the importance of crime prevention and safety?	10%
Creativity and Originality	Evaluate the uniqueness and originality of the design. Look for innovative approaches, visual impact, and imaginative use of colors, typography, and graphics.	10%
Message Clarity	Determine whether the poster conveys its intended message clearly and effectively. The poster should be easy to understand at a glance and engage the viewer's attention.	15%
Visual Impact	Consider the overall visual appeal of the poster. Look for a balanced layout, strong composition, and eye- catching elements that draw attention to the message.	15%
Typography	Evaluate the use of fonts and typography in the design. The text should be legible and appropriately sized, with a clear hierarchy to guide the viewer's reading order.	5%
Use of Imagery	Assess the quality and relevance of images, illustrations, or graphics used in the poster. Look for visuals that support the message and evoke an emotional response.	10%
Technical Skills	Consider the technical execution of the poster. Look for attention to detail, clean design elements, and proper image resolution suitable for digital viewing.	10%
Overall Impact	Evaluate the overall impact and effectiveness of the poster. Does it effectively communicate the importance of crime prevention? Does it inspire action or evoke a desired response from the viewer?	10%
