EASTERN VISAYAS YOUNG LEADERS CONGRESS

To: Schools Division Superintendents
All Others Concerned

1. Aligned to the MATATAG Agenda on Taking good care of the learners by promoting learner well-being, inclusive education, and a positive learning environment, and true to the thrust of the Learner Rights and Protection Office (LRPO) and the Learner Formation Division, this Region, in partnership with the 8th Civil-Military Operations Battalion (8CMOBn) 8th Infantry (Stormtroopers) Division Philippine Army and the Higher Education Institution (HEI), will conduct a two-day Eastern Visayas Young Leaders' Congress (EVYLC) at the Samar Island Natural Park (SINP), Brgy. Tinani, Paranas, Samar on September 23-24, 2023.

All the Schools Division Superintendents (SDSs), through the Division Learner Formation Coordinators should ensure that every learner has parents/guardian's duly accomplished and signed Consent Form, and that this document should be presented to the registration committee upon arrival. The identified guardians/chaperones of the learners should take utmost measures to ensure their safety.

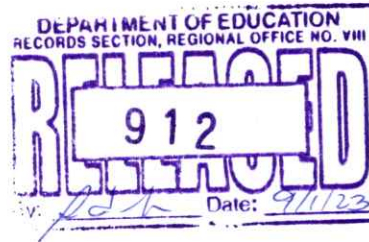
