5. Immediate dissemination of and compliance with this Memorandum are desired.

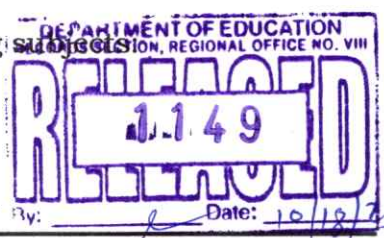



The Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Service (DRRMS), in partnership with UNICEF and Save Philippine Seas, has been implementing the Change the Current (CTC) training for secondary school-aged learners and DepEd personnel since 2021. The CTC is an interdisciplinary, localized, and participatory approach to climate change education. It is in line with the country's National Climate Change Action Plan 2011-2028, and the Philippine Development Plan (PDP) 2023-2028 that emphasize the roles of communication, education, training, and public awareness addressing the country's climate change concerns.

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The CTC 1.0 was an innovative co-curricular training programme that was developed based on a qualitative gap analysis of climate education in the country. It facilitated adolescent empowerment and civic engagement through participatory and meaningful community-based climate action. On the other hand, CTC 2.0 expands the programme by focusing on capacitating teachers in integrating climate change adaptation and mitigation concepts and relevant skills into different subject areas.

As of August 2023, all the training workshops for CTC 2.0 were already completed. As a culmination activity for the second phase of the Change the Current, a summit will be conducted to facilitate knowledge exchange, build, and strengthen networks among the CTC schools, and engage teachers in a CCAM project site. The CTC 2.0 Summit directly contributes to CTC 2.0's third objective which is to strengthen Climate Education and Action Community of Practice.

With this, the DepEd personnel indicated in Annex A (List of CTC 2.0 Summit Participants) are requested to participate in the CTC 2.0 Summit which will be conducted on November 8-10, 2023, exclusive of travel time, in Quezon City, Metro Manila.

The Participants are expected to:

1. Actively communicate with the CTC Summit Organizing team and Regional/Division office point person/s to arrange and coordinate logistics-related needs.
2. Complete all the sessions and actively participate in activities from November 8 to 10, 2023 to receive a certificate of appearance and participation.

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DepEd Regional/Division Offices are requested to provide logistical support in the implementation of the CTC Summit which include but not limited to:

1. Ensure that all selected participants are allowed and are excused from their professional obligations during the duration of the Summit, including the day/s needed to travel to and from Metro Manila (if applicable).
2. Assist in the coordination with the selected participants.

The CTC Summit will:

1. Arrange and pay for the participants' board and lodging in Metro Manila.
2. Pay for the participants' flights to and from Metro Manila.
3. Reimburse travel expenses to and from the participants' airport of origin, when applicable. (e.g., home to provincial/city airport; provincial/city airport to home). Subject to the program's travel expense reimbursement guidelines.

Coordinate with Luzon Divisions and participants (i.e., Angeles City and Valenzuela City) to arrange land transportation options to Metro Manila (e.g., van rental care of the program) or reimburse the participants' travel expenses, subject to the program's travel expense reimbursement guidelines.
