**FINAL UPDATES RE: POST MONITORING AND EVALUATION ON THE
 IMPLEMENTATION OF PROJECT KEY STAGE 1 FOUNDATIONS
 FOR EFFECTIVE LEARNING TRANSITION (K-3 FELT)**

To: Schools Division Superintendents
 All Others Concerned

1. This Office, through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD) with the support of the United Nations Children's Funds (UNICEF) and the Advancing Basic Education in the Philippines (ABC+), announces that the Post Monitoring and Evaluation on the Implementation of Project Key Stage 1 Foundations for Effective Learning Transition (K-3 FELT) shall be conducted on December 11-12, 2023 at the Ambassador's Hotel, Tacloban City.
2. The final composition of the participants in the activity is given below:
 - A. Regional Office
 - a. RD and ARD;
 - b. Functional Division Chiefs;
 - c. CLMD EPSs;
 - d. CLMD-LR Support Staff;
 - B. Schools Division Offices (7 per SDO)
 - a. CID Chiefs;
 - b. Division Literacy Focal Persons (MTB, Filipino, and English);
 - c. Division Numeracy Focal Persons;
 - d. Division M&E Focal Persons; and
 - e. School Heads.
3. It is required that each of the SDOs has the complete submission through Google Forms of the pre and post assessment results, data on the Classroom Implementation Checklist, Strategy Application, and Surveys for Teachers, Learners, and Instructional Leaders. The hard copy of the checklist and surveys must be brought to the venue for information validation of the data captured online.
4. Moreover, a 5-minute video presentation of the accomplishments/best practices relative to the Project K-3 FELT implementation per SDO shall be presented during the activity. Such shall give the UNICEF, ABC+, and the Director of DepEd Project Management Service a full picture of the project implementation. The canned video must be forwarded to the Regional Office on or before December 10, 2023.
5. Each of the participants is expected to bring along with them a laptop and extension wires for the workshop on the project data analysis.

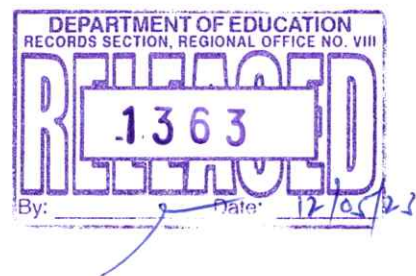

There shall also be a visit by the PMS Team after the Opening Program to a school in Tacloban City Division and another nearby school in Leyte Division to validate the Project K-3 FELT implementation feedbacks and an interview on Mental Health by the UNICEF with the Regional and Division Personnel from the same SDOs. The Regional Project Development Officer (PDO) and the Regional Numeracy Focal Person shall facilitate the school visit and the interview. The concerned Schools Division Superintendents, through the CID and SGOD Chiefs, shall extend full support to the said activity.
7. Expenses for the board and lodging shall be shouldered by UNICEF while travel and other related expenditures of the field participants incurred in the post M&E activity including that of the school visits and interview shall be charged against School/Division Local Funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
8. Other provisions of the previous Memoranda consistent with this issuance remain in effect.
9. Immediate dissemination of and strict compliance with this Memorandum are desired.
