The target participants are Science classroom teachers and learners from both public and private schools.

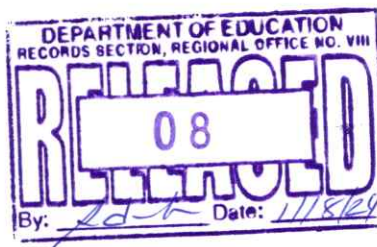

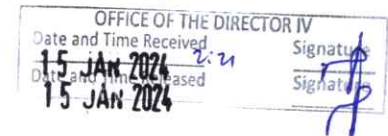
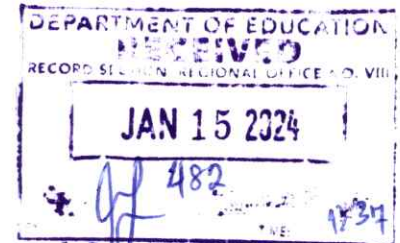
