INVITATION TO THE 2ND NATIONAL CONVENTION AND GENERAL ASSEMBLY

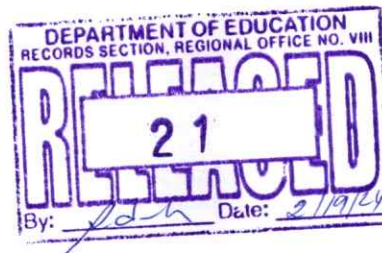

Considering that this is an Advisory, Schools Division Superintendents are given the discretion to act on this matter.

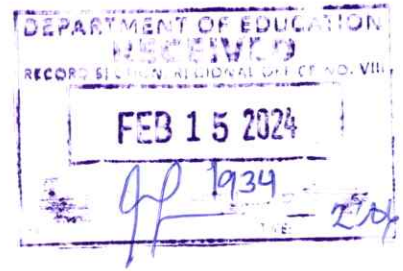

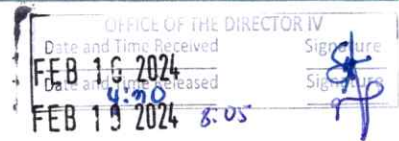

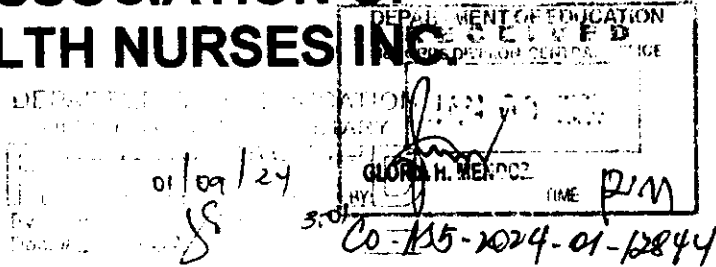
