

## REALIGNMENT OF THE REGIONAL MONITORING, EVALUATION, AND ADJUSTMENT (RMEA) SYSTEM

To: Schools Division Superintendents Regional Office Division Chiefs All Others Concerned

- 1. This Office, through the Quality Assurance Division, in its efforts to respond to the concern raised during the 2023 Quarter 4 Program Implementation Review (PIR), and to strengthen the monitoring and evaluation in the region, thereby informs all those concerned DepEd personnel on the realignment of the Regional Monitoring, Evaluation, and Adjustment (RMEA) System.
- 2. The purpose of the enhancement is to provide real-time and meaningful utilization of the monitoring and evaluation results according to the lenses of the offices of the PIR exits.
- 3. Refer to the enclosed Framework which details the expected outputs in the different processes of the enhanced RMEA System leading towards the exits of the Program Implementation Review (PIR) and the provision of technical assistance.




Based on the above framework, the exits of the PIR provide the Analysis and Evaluation to the Functional Divisions and other interested parties according to the





purpose of their utilization of the data – Adjustment of Plans/WFP, PAPs Implementation Adjustment, TA Planning, Policy Review/Recommendation, Research Agenda, Database, and others.

Below are the timelines as bases in the conduct of various Monitoring and Evaluation and Technical Assistance-related activities:



Accordingly, the activities for a quarter follow the timelines in the matrix below:

Activities	Timeline
Pre-PIR (Scoping)	Week before a quarter
Completed Staff Work (CSW)	1st week of the 1st month of the quarter
PIR-SDO/RO	2nd – 3 <sup>rd</sup> week
Post-PIR Workshop	3rd week
TA Planning	4th week
TA Provision	1st two weeks in the succeeding month
PAPs M&E (as needed)	3rd week to the remaining weeks of the quarter

The PAPs M&E shall be done as needed/mandated by DepEd, Central Office or upon instruction of the Top Management, thereby giving priority to the deployment of the RFTACT. The results of all M&E activities including those conducted by PAP focal persons shall be reported to the PIR to form part of the quarterly report.

5. Immediate dissemination of and compliance with this Memorandum is desired.
