4. Committee on Decorum and Investigation (CODI): Creation, Functions, and Membership.

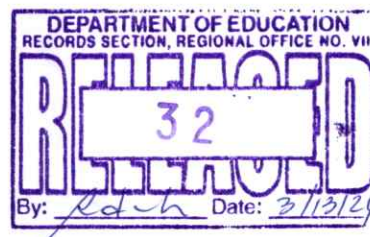
