1. This Department of Education, Regional Office No. VIII announces that the request for **Conversion of San Isidro Elementary School to San Isidro Integrated School**, Brgy. San Isidro, San Julian, Eastern Samar, was approved by this Regional Office on April 5, 2024, through administrative fiat pursuant to its expressed authority under Section 5 (B/13) of Chapter 1 of RA No. 9155 (The Governance of Basic Education Act of 2001), after full satisfactory compliance with the requirements prescribed by existing guidelines and policies of the Department.

2. The **Schools Division Superintendent** of the **Division of Eastern Samar** is hereby directed to consider this school in budget preparation for its eventual inclusion in the immediately succeeding General Appropriations Act (GAA).

EVALUATION AND RECOMMENDATION REPORT OF SCHOOL'S APPLICATION

Name of School: SAN ISIDRO ELEMENTARY SCHOOL (122730)
School Address: BRGY. SAN ISIDRO, SAN JULIAN, EASTERN SAMAR
Type of application: CONVERSION OF SAN ISIDRO ELEMENTARY SCHOOL TO SAN ISIDRO INTEGRATED SCHOOL

FINDINGS:

1. Barangay San Isidro is one of the 16 barangays in San Julian, Eastern Samar and is strategically situated as a catchment area of Brgy. San Miguel, Brgy. Bunacan and Brgy. Pagbabangnan.
2. San Isidro Elementary School has had a significant increase of enrolment from school years 2021 to 2023 as reflected in Table 2: Enrolment Profile for the last three Years of the feasibility study submitted.
3. It can be surmised from the study submitted that students coming from the catchment barangays are enrolled in San Julian National High School.
4. San Julian National High School is congested with students coming from the catchment barangays.
5. According to the educational survey conducted, San Isidro Elementary School is 4 kilometers away from the town proper of San Julian where San Julian National High School, the nearest high school to San Isidro. This means that the elementary graduates from San Isidro Elementary School need to spend P40.00 per day for them to attend high school in San Julian.
6. As shown in the Certificate of Land Title, San Isidro Elementary School has a total land area of 5,925 square meters.
7. The school has one available classroom and another two repairable classrooms which can be used for the opening of Grade 7.
8. Per MGB clearance issued, it was noted that San Isidro Elementary School, San Julian, Eastern Samar is classified as having Low Landslide Susceptibility Rating.
9. The school is located along the carline part of the barangay with a total population of 214 learners.
10. The school applicant is subject to the provisions outlined in the approved Resolution No. 58, s. 2022 "A Resolution Supporting the Conversion through Expansion of San Isidro Elementary School in San Isidro Integrated School.
11. The Local Government Unit, represented by Hon. Dennis P. Estaron, signed a certification certifying that the repair and maintenance of the classrooms, school facilities, and funding sources for the operation of the school **shall be shouldered by the Local Government Unit** for at least five years or until such time that it will be incorporated in the national budget.



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RECOMMENDATIONS


In view of the foregoing evaluation and findings, the team respectfully recommends that:

1. In order to respond to the need of the community and to completely provide access to basic education in the said locality in the absence of a separate school site for the proposed secondary school, the San Isidro Elementary School shall be converted to an integrated school and shall be named **SAN ISIDRO INTEGRATED SCHOOL** and is authorized to operate effective School Year 2024 – 2025.
2. The school shall offer K to 12 Basic Education Curriculum.
3. The Curriculum Grades to offer upon opening of classes for School Year 2024-2025 should only be Grade 7. The progression of its expansion for the next grade levels of Junior High School shall depend on the availability of the required resources upon approval of the Schools Division Superintendent.
4. The Schools Division Superintendent shall:
 - a. provide teachers trained on the K to 12 Curriculum and consider adding regular teachers to this school to complete the number of teachers required to operate the integrated school.
 - b. review and finalize the assignment of school head to manage the said integrated school.
 - c. Facilitate the adjustment/updating of the school profile in the LIS/EBEIS.
 - d. provide additional school furniture (i.e., chairs, tables), textbooks, and other learning resources to the school.
 - e. Facilitate the implementation of the identified budgetary requirements and inclusion, as an integrated school, in the General Appropriation Act (GAA); and
 - f. Monitor the operation of San Isidro Integrated School.
