- 1. In accordance with the Philippine Independence Day celebration (Presidential Proclamation No. 110, s. 1963 titled *Declaring June 12 as Philippine Independence Day*) and Administrative Order No. 23, s. 2011, titled *Creating a Steering Committee on National Observances*, all government agencies are directed to cooperate with and fully support the activities of the Committee chaired by the National Historical Commission of the Philippines (NHCP).
- 2. Consistent with the previous issuances, Administrative Order No. 8, s. 2023 titled Creating an Inter-Agency Committee for the Commemoration of the 125th Anniversary of Philippine Independence and Nationhood, was likewise issued, naming the Department of Education (DepEd) as a member of the Committee which is tasked to plan and execute programs and projects relative to the Philippine Independence Day Celebration from 2023 to 2026 with the theme "Kalayaan, Kinabukasan, Kasaysayan."

3. The celebration has the following objectives:

Commemorate the heroism, patriotism, nationalism, and self-sacrifice of our Filipino forefathers in the struggle for independence;

 Instill in the hearts and minds of the Filipino youth the greatness of the Filipino race, the legacy of national heroes, and the ideals

of Filipino nationhood; and

Show unity and strength during challenging times.

- 4. In support of this, the National Educators Academy of the Philippines (NEAP) will conduct the Continuing Professional Development (CPD) Accredited 126th Independence Day Commemoration: Master Class Professional Development Program for Teachers and School Leaders on 10-11 June 2024 (a separate advisory will be issued on the final venue). This is in collaboration with the Bureau of Curriculum Development (BCD), Bureau of Learning Delivery (BLD), Information and Communications Technology Service (ICTS), Public Affairs Service (PAS), and Professional Regulation Commission (PRC).
- 5. Distinguished Philippine historians will serve as the program's resource persons and subject matter experts, delivering training sessions anchored on the multi-year theme "Kalayaan, Kinabukasan, Kasaysayan," which focuses on the freedom that our forebears struggled for and the history that we seek to remember and honor them with.
- 6. The program will be conducted in two (2) modalities, as follows:
 - Face-to-face for select school heads; and
 - Online for interested teachers and school leaders.
- 7. Attached is the List of Select School Heads as Face-to-Face Participants (Enclosure 1). All other interested teachers and school leaders may virtually join the program through the official Facebook page of DepEd Philippines which can be accessed through the link www.facebook.com/DepartmentOfEducation.PH.
- 8. Since the program falls within their mandatory vacation, all interested teachers are reminded that their participation is **not required** and is **purely voluntary**. This is in adherence to DepEd Order No. 003, s. 2024 titled Amendment to DepEd Order No. 022, s. 2023 (Implementing Guidelines on the School Calendar and Activities for the School Year 2023-2024), as reiterated by a memorandum from the Office of the Undersecretary for Operations DM-OUOPS-2024-02-01300 titled Guidance on the Mandatory 30-Day Vacation of Teachers.
- 9. To ensure the quality of the program, online participants are requested to comply with the following requirements before joining the training:
 - Secure a stable internet connection activities and other forms
 of online assessments will only be available during the given
 timeframe announced in the sessions;
 - Late submission of outputs will not be accepted only those who
 have completed all the session requirements within the allotted
 time will receive a Certificate of Participation;
 - The Certificates of Participation will only be issued to participants after they have completed the three sessions and submitted the required outputs and evaluation of the sessions;







- Participants should register at the end of each session registration/attendance link will only be available during the live session.
- 10. Likewise attached are the *Program of Activities* (Enclosure 2) and the *Abstract of the Sessions* (Enclosure 3).
- 11. The meals of face-to-face participants will be charged against NEAP Human Resource Development (HRD) Funds while their transportation, per diem, and other incidental expenses will be charged against local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.


