- Teach Less and Learn More (Presenter: Leader Singapore Teachers' Union)
- Developing Educational Structures for Happiness and Sustainability: Experiences and Policies of Country (Presenter: Leader - Teachers' Council of Thailand)
- Teacher Professional Development for Happiness and Sustainability in Education (Presenter: Leader - National Education Union of Vietnam)
