II. Meal Allowance

Funds for meal allowance which includes morning snacks, lunch, and afternoon snacks during the conduct of the event shall be downloaded to DepEd Region I subject to the existing accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

III. Registration / Event Tickets/ DepEd or School IDs

As part of the pre-registration process, each RO must email the complete list of their teacher-participants in MS Excel file to the EPS through external.partnerships@deped.gov.ph not later than August 23, 2024 following the format shown in Enclosure 2.

Subject of the email should be: "Region ____ List of 2024 NTM Participants."

The EPS shall email the e-tickets to the Regional Focal Persons (RFPs) only. The region/ division coordinators shall facilitate the printing of the event tickets and ensure that the registered participants receive their e-tickets. Each participant should bring their own printed event ticket (or e-copy) which will be presented at the gate of the event venue. Each event ticket has a unique code, which will be scanned upon entrance. This will ensure security, safety, and participation in the activities including the raffle draws.

All participants are advised to bring their DepEd or School ID, which will be presented together with the e-tickets at the entrance gates and upon claiming of raffle prize (if applicable). Kindly note that only participants with e-tickets shall be allowed entry. E-tickets are non-transferable.

The hard copy of the accomplished Attendance Sheet (signed by each participant) **MUST** be submitted in **three** (3) copies by the Regional Partnership Focal Person (RPFP) prior to the conduct of the activity or at the Registration Area upon entrance (September 5, 2024). The attached Attendance Sheet template prescribed by Region I-SDO Candon City must be used in compliance with their accounting rules and regulations.

IV. Regional Partnership Focal Persons (RPFPs)

Each region should assign their respective RFPs whom the organizing team may coordinate regarding the participants' information and other necessary details. The name and contact details of the RFPs must be sent via email to external partnerships adeped gov.ph with the subject "2024 NTM Regional Focal Person".

V. Raffle Mechanics

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- 1. All public teachers who registered through the registration link are entitled to win Minor prizes (pre-drawn)
- 2. All participants present during the NTM Kick-Off are entitled to win the Major prizes.
- 3. Teachers who registered beyond the registration cut-off will not be included in the Major Raffle.
- 4. Minor raffle draw will be conducted prior to the event with the presence of EPS and SDO Candon City. The winners will be announced during the 2024 NTM Kick-Off.
- 5. Major raffle draw will take place during the NTM Kick-Off on September 5, 2024 at the Candon City Arena, Candon City. Winners will be determined using the electronic raffle draw.
- 6. All Major prize winners should be present during the raffle draw announcement to claim their prize. Failure to do so will mean forfeiture and the prize will be raffled off again.
- 7. Winners must acknowledge provide valid ID upon claiming of prizes.
- 8. A teacher can only win once during the raffle.

VI. Teachers' Fair

A Teachers' Fair shall be set-up at the event venue. The fair shall feature exhibits, food booths, giveaways, and tokens from our partner stakeholders.

VII. Schedule of Activities

The gates of the event venue shall open as early as 6:00 a.m. Booths at the Teachers' Fair shall also be open around the same time for the participants to visit once they have arrived at the venue.

VIII. Certificates of Appearance

Participants shall be given Certificates of Appearance which will be claimed by the RPFPs from the registration area after the event. The RPFPs shall facilitate the distribution of the certificates to the participants from their respective regions.

IX. Parking Areas

Due to the limited space of the event venue, vehicles must be parked at the designated parking areas outside the event venue. Thus, the participants may only be dropped off at the designated areas near the venue. There will be street signage, traffic enforcers, and/or police officers that will serve as guide as to where the parking areas are located.

There will also be a designated drop-off and parking area for DepEd CO Officials and Regional Directors. Please coordinate with the Secretariat for the issuance of CAR PASS for proper identification.


