IPA is inviting teachers and school leaders to participate in the said activity.

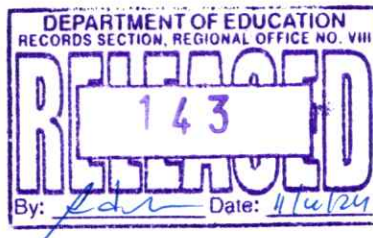

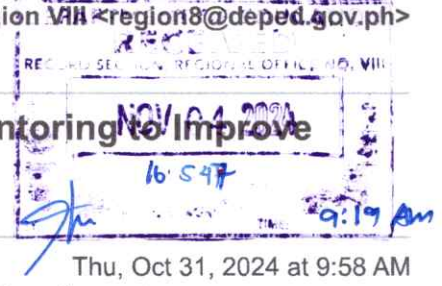

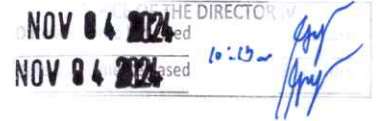

Innovations for Poverty Action (IPA) is an international non-profit research organization that discovers and promotes effective solutions to global poverty problems. For the past 20 years, IPA has been at the forefront of rigorous research on poverty-related issues. In November 2023, IPA launched the [Best Bets: Emerging Opportunities for Impact at Scale](#) report. The report showcases fourteen innovations that IPA's sector experts and scientific advisors believe hold the most promise for making an impact at scale, but require additional investment to advance along the path to scale.

## BEST BETS IN THE PHILIPPINES

IPA Philippines has chosen four Best Bets that are highly relevant in the Philippines: (i) **teacher mentoring to improve student learning**, (ii) **digital payments to improve financial health**, (iii) **payment for ecosystem services to reduce deforestation and protect the environment**, and (iv) **cognitive behavioral therapy to reduce crime**. Through a series of webinars, we will dig deeper into each of these best bets, explore their applicability in the Philippines together with key players in these respective fields from academia, government, and civil society organizations. The webinar series will provide a platform to explore opportunities for further research and collaboration.

## TEACHER MENTORING TO IMPROVE STUDENT LEARNING

In IPA's best bets report, global evidence has shown that **teacher mentoring**, in which dedicated educational professionals or “teacher coaches” provide training, advice, and feedback to in-service teachers, is an effective intervention that has the potential to increase student learning.

IPA Philippines is honored to guide this discussion and join forces to identify concrete collaboration opportunities to build a stronger evidence base for teacher mentoring.
