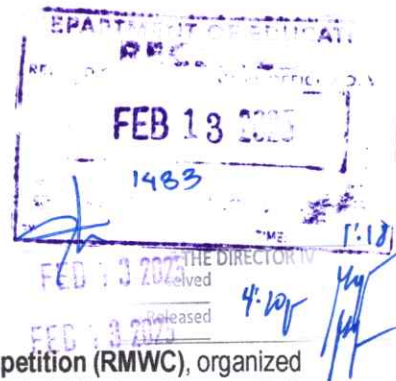

Regional Math Wizards Competition

2025 RMWC Contest Guidelines

The **Regional Math Wizards Competition**, organized by the **Mathematics Trainers' Guild Philippines – Eastern Visayas**, in partnership with **Philippine Science High School – Eastern Visayas Campus**, is an exhilarating event designed to bring together the brightest mathematics students from various schools in Region VIII. This competition is a fantastic opportunity for students to demonstrate their problem-solving skills and mathematical knowledge. Whether you're a math enthusiast or a budding mathematician, this event promises to be both challenging and rewarding.

Here are the general guidelines for the competition:

1. Qualifications and Team Formation

- Participants in this contest must be students enrolled in the school they are representing for the school year 2024-2025.
- Each school shall form a group of three participants for each category.
- Schools are not required to participate in all categories, but any category they do participate in must have a group of three participants.
- **No Registration Fee** shall be collected from the participants.

2. Categories

The competition will be divided into four categories:

- Upper Primary: Grade 5-6
- Junior Category: Grade 7-8
- Intermediate Category: Grade 9-10
- Senior Category: Grade 11-12

3. Coverage

- Contest items will encompass topics outlined in the K-12 Basic Education Curriculum, tailored to each educational level.

4. Test Format

- All participants will complete a paper-and-pen test consisting of 25 items.
- The test will include 10 multiple-choice questions (MCQs) worth 2 points each, 10 routine short-answer questions worth 4 points each, and 5 non-routine questions requiring full solutions worth 8 points each.
- All participants will have 90 minutes to complete the test and must stop immediately after this period. If participants finish before the time ends, they are not allowed to leave the room. All participants will leave the room together after the facilitator gives the signal.



5. Scoring Methods

- Individual Scoring:
 - Participants scoring 96-100 points will be awarded a Gold Medal.
 - Participants scoring 91-95 points will be awarded a Silver Medal.
 - Participants scoring 86-90 points will be awarded a Bronze Medal.
 - Participants scoring 75-85 points will receive a Mathematics Achievement Certificate.
- Group Scoring:

The scores of the three participants in each group will be combined. The top three schools in each category will be awarded as follows:

 - Champion
 - First Runner-Up
 - Second Runner-Up
- In the event of a tie in group scoring, the school that answered the most non-routine questions will break the tie. If a tie still remains, the number of routine questions answered will be considered.

6. Competition Rules

- Only the registered participants per school shall be recognized to take part of this competition.
- Participants may not wear their school uniforms; however, they must wear their school ID all throughout the duration of the competition.
- Calculator, cellphones, smart watches and other gadgets are not allowed during the Contest Proper.
- Coaches and parents have designated area for them to wait for the participants during the Contest Proper.
- Participants may bring water and light foods in the contest rooms provided that they practice CLAYGO.
- Participants will be assigned to the room corresponding to their category.
- A 5-minute pre-test instruction session will be conducted to inform participants of the competition rules and procedures.
- Cheating, in any form, will lead to a disqualification of the participant.
- Guidelines may be revised upon the review of the program management team, if deemed necessary. Participants and coaches shall be notified of any changes before the contest proper.
