In line with this mission, TDC will hold the National Seminar-Workshop on Education Policy Advocacy and Legal Protection for Teachers from May 1 to 3, 2025, at the Great Eastern Hotel, Quezon City. With the theme "Empowering Teachers Through Enhanced Legal Rights Education," the event, which coincides with the group's 6th National Convention, aligns with the Department's efforts to strengthen teacher protection and promote their welfare.

This seminar will be attended by some 500 teachers, administrators and other education workers and advocates from all over the country. The event aims to elevate teachers' morale and productivity by fostering a supportive and conducive working environment.

The specific objectives of the event are as follows:

- b. Inform the participants about educational issues and solicit ideas for reform;
- c. Empower teachers and administrators with essential legal skills; and
- Develop policy recommendations to address current challenges faced by teachers and learners.

Each participant will be charged a minimal registration fee of five thousand pesos (\$\P\$5,000.00) to cover expenses for board and lodging, materials, speakers' honoraria, and incidental costs. Registration and billeting will begin at 1:00PM on the first day, May 1, check-out time is at 12:00NN of the third day, May 3.
