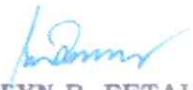
1. 2. Likewise, any similar expenses incurred by Division personnel involved in the monitoring process, as coordinated with the Regional ALS focal person, will be charged against their respective downloaded ALS Funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
5. The Schools Division Offices, through their respective Division ALS Focal Persons, shall coordinate with their respective Supply Officers relative to the preparation and accomplishment of the required documents. They may also submit financial reports to the RMT4TP on the utilization of the downloaded FY 2023 ALS funds.
