We hope this letter finds you well. We've had the pleasure of working with your region through one of our environmental education programs, Change the Current – Education for Climate Action (CTC). From 2023 to 2024, CTC engaged the Schools Division Offices of Samar and Northern Samar, along with selected educators from these divisions. This partnership resulted in the active participation of 58 educators. In 2024, we invited several CTC alumni to join the training team that worked with educators in Southern Leyte.

This year, we are pleased to invite Ms. Jimmy Alfonso of Lope De Vega Standalone Senior High School, Division of Northern Samar, to participate in our upcoming Earthducation Summit, which will be held from July 30 to August 1, 2025, in Quezon City.

The two-and-a-half-day Earthducation Summit aims to bring together educators who have successfully implemented a project-based learning (PBL) climate action plan, as well as those who have integrated environmental concepts into their lesson plans and school activities. The summit will include

- Reporting of environmental education activities and showcasing of participants' achievements
- Knowledge-exchange sessions to strengthen networks among participating Schools Division Offices (SDOs)
- Experiential learning activity through a visit to a climate change adaptation and mitigation (CCAM) project site

Ms. Alfonso was one of our outstanding participants in 2023, during which she pitched a project-based learning (PBL) action plan that she successfully implemented in her school with the support of a small grant from our organization. In 2024, she served as one of our teacher-facilitators, training educators in Southern Leyte on climate change education and PBL. Her continued dedication to climate action led her to propose and complete another climate action project in 2024.
