INVITATION FOR STUDENTS TO PARTICIPATE IN THE #YAMANGKALAWAKAN POSTER MAKING AND POETRY WRITING CONTESTS OF THE PHILIPPINE SPACE AGENCY

Greetings from the Philippine Space Agency (PhilSA)!

The Philippine Space Agency, the central government agency mandated on addressing all national issues and activities related to space science and technology applications, is annually celebrating the Philippine Space Week (PSW) every 8 to 14 August. This year, the agency is organizing two (2) competitions for elementary and high school students, as follows:

1.	#YamangKalawakan Poster-Making Contest	The activity will serve as the national qualifier to select three Filipino representatives for the annual Asia Pacific Regional Space Agency Forum (APRSAF) Poster Contest. Open to students aged 6 to 12 from public and private schools, the contest aims to foster interest in space science, provide a creative outlet aligned with the 2025 theme <i>"Lunar City"</i> .
2.	#YamangKalawakan Poetry Writing Contest (Tula Para sa Mga Buntabay ng Pilipinas)	The poetry competition is open to all Filipinos aged 9 to 25 and is divided into four categories: Elementary (Grades 4–6), Secondary (Grades 7–12), Tertiary (undergraduate and Tech-Voc students), and Open (graduate students, professionals, and other interested individuals).
		Entries must be original, unpublished works written in Filipino, and must not have been submitted to or awarded by any other competition.
		Each poem should reflect the theme "Yamang Kalawakan, Para sa Mundo, Para sa Bayan" focusing on honoring Philippine satellites—Mula, Diwata, and Maya—and the Filipinos behind these space resources.

In connection with this, we are requesting your good office to disseminate this invitation to all public and private schools within your region. Attached in this letter are the mechanics and guidelines for the two (2) contests.

PhilSA will contact the finalists/winners who shall also be invited to an awarding ceremony on 9 August 2025 in Quezon City. Similarly, the names of the finalists/winners and their schools shall be promoted in PhilSA's website and social media pages.

#YamangKalawakan Poster-Making Contest (Country level contest for APRSAF-31)

MECHANICS AND GUIDELINES

The #YamangKalawakan Poster-Making Contest aims to foster creativity and artistic expression while promoting awareness of space science and technology applications among elementary learners. It encourages participants to visually communicate complex scientific concepts—in this case, the theme "Lunar City"—thereby enhancing their critical thinking, and presentation skills.

The activity also serves as the local contest to determine the country's official entries to the 31st Asia-Pacific Regional Space Agency Forum (APRSAF) Space Education for All Working Group (SE4AWG) Poster Contest in November 2025.

Challenge

Through a poster, showcase your interpretation of the theme "Lunar City".

Contest Mechanics and Guidelines

- The contest is open to Filipino students aged 6 to 12 years by 31 December 2025 (Date of birth between 1 January 2013 to 31 December 2019) from any public or private school in the Philippines. It will be on an individual basis only.
- 2. Relatives of the Philippine Space Agency (PhilSA) employees up to the 2nd degree of consanguinity and affinity are ineligible from joining the contest.
- 3. The posters should align with the theme: "Lunar City".
- 4. The posters must comply with the following:

Artwork	Each submission must be an original, individual creation by
	 the student as verified through a signed certification/declaration of authenticity. Artwork must be created on a flat sheet of paper. The poster entry must use an A3 paper size (297 x 420mm) in a portrait orientation. Only traditional art materials are allowed, including pencils,
	crayons, watercolors, and oils (including oil pastel). Digital artwork will not be accepted.
Prohibitions	Artwork that violates any of the following rules will be disqualified from the Poster Awards voting process:

	 Do not create photo collages or attach 3D objects to the artwork. Artwork must not include letters or characters, artist signatures, national flags, country names or abbreviations, or the names of space agencies. Artwork must not depict or reference any specific person, organization, country, brand, logo, or religious theme.

Submission	Only one entry per person is allowed.		
	Participants must accomplish the registration form (including attachments) and submit it together with a scanned copy/photo of their birth certificate and their completed artwork to the designated point of contact (Space Education and Scholarships Division, Philippine Space Agency) via https://tinyurl.com/YKPosterContest. 	Participants must submit their original work via courier to the		
	Philippine Space Agency's office at 29th Floor Cyber One Bldg., 11 Eastwood Ave., Bagumbayan, Quezon City. To ensure the artwork remains undamaged, participants must roll and securely place it in a protective scroll or tube that accommodates A3-sized paper. Folded submissions will not be accepted.		
	 All poster submissions must be clearly labeled with the participant's name, school, and contact information, using the official entry slip (page 3 of the registration form). 		
Copyright	All submitted works will remain the property of their respective owners but may be used by the PhilSA and JAXA/APRSAF secretariats for publications, websites, social media, educational materials, and other informational content exclusively for the promotion of space education.		

- 5. The top 20 posters shall be displayed during the Philippine Space Week celebration (8-14 August 2025) and may be opened for public voting.
- 6. The Panel of Judges shall use the following criteria to determine the winners:

Originality and relevance to the theme (40%) Artistic execution and presentation (50%) Overall impact (10%)

7. The winners shall be awarded the following cash prizes:

First Place	PhP 20,000.00
Second Place	PhP 15,000.00
Third Place	PhP 10,000.00
PhilSA Crewmates' Choice	PhP 5,000.00

The top three winning posters shall represent the country in the APRSAF-31 Poster contest. The winning entries shall be available for public viewing both on-site and online:

- On-site: At the APRSAF-31 venue from November 18th to 21st, 2025
- Online: APRSAF-31 Poster Contest website from October 28th, 2025

#YamangKalawakan Poetry Writing Contest (Tula Para sa Mga Buntabay ng Pilipinas)

MECHANICS AND GUIDELINES

Proclamation No. 302 s. 2023 declared every 08 to 14 August as the Philippine Space Week (PSW) to promote space awareness, highlight the contribution of Filipinos worldwide in the field of space science, and espouse the value, benefits, and impacts of space science and technology applications (SSTA) on the lives of Filipinos. The celebration of this year's PSW held under the theme #YamangKalawakan, Para sa Mundo, Para sa Bayan, also marks the 6th Anniversary of the Agency. A series of stakeholder and public engagement activities will take place to commemorate this milestone. One of these activities is the conduct of a poetry contest dubbed "#Yamang Kalawakan Poetry Contest: Mga Tula para sa mga Buntabay ng Pilipinas" which aims to pay homage to the series of satellites designed, developed, and assembled by Filipino researchers and engineers.

This contest provides a platform for students of all genders across all levels of education to showcase their creativity and artistic expression while promoting space science and technology applications. It encourages participants to make connections between science, arts and literature.

Contest Mechanics and Guidelines

- 1. This competition is open to all Filipinos 9 25 years old and has the following categories:
 - a. Elementary covers Grades 4 to Grade 6 learners
 - b. Secondary covers Grade 7 to Grade 12 learners
 - c. Tertiary covers undergraduate students and students in tech-voc programs
 - d. Open covers graduate students, professionals and other interested individuals
- 2. Officials and employees of PhilSA and their relatives up to second degree of affinity or consanguinity are not eligible to join the contest.
- 3. The entry must comply with the following:
 - a. The poem must be an original composition and must have not been previously submitted to, selected in, or awarded by any other competition, nor published in any form—print, digital, or online platforms (including personal blogs, social media, or literary websites). Simultaneous submissions are not allowed
 - b. The piece must be written in Filipino.
 - c. The poem must be related to the theme "Yamang Kalawakan, Para sa Mundo, Para sa Bayan" with focus on paying homage to the satellites of the Philippines, namely Mula, Diwata and Maya, and the Filipinos who designed, developed and assembled them.

- d. Entries may be written in any form or style of poetry but should NOT exceed 1 page of an A4-sized bond paper.
- e. Al-generated_entries will not be accepted and are automatically disqualified
- f. In the case of Al-assisted work, participants should declare the extent Al was used. The only acceptable use of Al is when looking for substitute or alternate words such as synonym, antonym, and rhyming terms to enhance word play.
- 4. Participants will have to download the submission form https://bit.ly/YKRequiredForms and prepare the supporting documents before submitting their entries through any of the following:

- 5. Only one entry per person is allowed. Entries must follow the following format for submission:
 - i. A4 sized document, saved in PDF
 - ii. Font style: Arial, size: 12
 - iii. Single spaced
 - iv. 1-inch margin from the sides, top, and bottom
- The deadline for submission is July 6, 2025. Only entries with complete documents will be evaluated.
- 7. All submitted works will remain the property of their respective owners but may be used by PhilSA for publications, websites, social media, educational materials, and other informational content exclusively for the promotion of space education.
- 8. The panel of judges shall use the following criteria to determine the winners:

Criteria	Description	Weight
Content and relevance to the theme	Explores the theme in meaningful ways and conveys a clear and engaging message.	30 %

Artistry and Originality	The poem demonstrates originality of thought and style in an artistic and creative way.	30 %
Use of language	Uses purposeful and effective words to articulate message with clarity, fluid, and clear thoughts	30 %
Impact	The poem evokes intellectual and emotional experience	10%

9. Three winning entries per category shall be awarded during the celebration of Philippine Space Week on August 09 and shall receive the following cash prize

First Place	PhP 10,000.00
Second Place	PhP 5,000.00
Third Place	PhP 3,000.00

- 10. First place winners in each category will present their piece orally during the awarding program.
- 11. The winning students and their coaches/guardians shall be flown in and billeted for two nights in Manila for the Awarding Ceremony on 9 August 2025 during the Philippine Space Week. The expenses for the air fare/transportation, lodging and accommodation shall be charged against the Education and Scholarships Program (ESP). Participants are required to present and submit the original receipts addressed to the Philippine Space Agency to claim the reimbursement.


