The target participants are student-leaders, of which the organization has selected two (2) as representative of the region and would serve as members of the Regional Council.

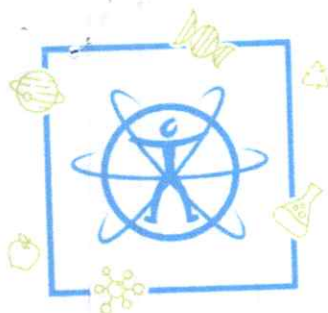

- I. **Pambansang Kapisanan ng mga Kabataan Samahan ng Agham (Philippine Society of Youth Science Clubs or PSYSC), Inc.** is a national organization that promotes the public understanding of science, technology and environment (PUSTE). It supports science and technology education through healthy competitions, lectures, seminars and interactive workshops for students and teachers alike.
- II. To accomplish its objectives, PSYSC is holding the **2025 National Leadership Enhancement and Development Seminar (NLEAD)**, an annual four day-long training-seminar designed to equip and prepare highly capable student-leaders from each region who are committed and passionate in serving their Regional Councils.
- III. The 2025 NLEAD Seminar aims to:
  - A. Provide free and accessible leadership training to deserving student leaders from across all regions;
  - B. Sustain the science clubbing movement at the grassroots by empowering and training the next Regional Council officers;
  - C. Equip and prepare highly capable student-leaders with the needed skills in leadership communication, project management, and advocacy campaigns through a series of lectures, workshops, and team-building activities.
- IV. The theme and dates for the 2025 NLEAD are as follows:

<b>Theme:</b>	Lucent: Illuminating Leadership, Magnifying Change
<b>Dates:</b>	July 25-28, 2025
<b>Venue:</b>	FarmKO, Sitio Central, Dolores, Quezon

- V. The target participants for the 2025 NLEAD are selected high school students (Grades 10-12) with two (2) representatives per region, upon assessment. The eligible applicants by the organizers. The event promotes the development of essential leadership skills among student leaders and the sustained growth of the science clubbing movement. By offering comprehensive training, the event aims to empower young leaders to effectively serve their communities and advance the public understanding of science, technology, society, and the environment (PUSTE).
