REGIONAL MEMORANDUM

**IN-PERSON LEARNING SESSION ON GETTING STARTED WITH THE
KHAN ACADEMY FOR MATHEMATICS, SCIENCE, AND
ALTERNATIVE LEARNING SYSTEM (ALS)**

To: Schools Division Superintendents
All Others Concerned

1. This Office, through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division and in collaboration with the Khan Academy Philippines, will conduct the In-person Learning Session on Getting Started the Khan Academy for Mathematics, Science, and ALS on July 19 and July 20, 2025 for Batches 1 and 2, respectively. The specific venue will be announced on a separate issuance.
2. The activity aims to provide the participants with a comprehensive understanding of the various features of the Khan Academy platform and how these elements can supplement classroom instruction and support a growth mindset among learners.
3. The participants include the teachers identified by the schools which will implement the Khan Academy and have passed the second validation stage. The list of the schools and allotted number of participants per school will be given on another issuance upon completion of the validation stage. There is an expected total of 300 teacher-participants, with 150 per batch per day, together with the four (4) technical working group from Khan Academy Philippines and the CLMD.
4. The participants are to bring their laptops or tablets, with backup internet connectivity modems, and extension wire for the workshop proper.
5. The participants in this activity who travel or render services on days that fall on weekends and holidays can avail of the service credit, CTO, or COC equivalent to eight hours of service per day whichever is applicable per DepEd Order No. 67, s. 1988 and CSC Memo Circular No. 09, s. 1988.
6. The venue and food (lunch and two snacks) shall be charged to the Basic Education Curriculum and Flexible Learning Options Funds, while the travel, accommodation, and other incidental expenses incurred by the participants shall be

charged to their respective local funds or other available sources, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

7. Immediate dissemination and compliance of this Memorandum are desired.
