**PARTICIPATION OF SELECTED GRADE 6 LEARNERS FROM DEPED REGION
VIII IN THE MATH CHRONICLES**

To: Schools Division Superintendents
Education Program Supervisors in Mathematics
School Heads
All Others Concerned

1. To support the implementation of Project ARAL (Academic Recovery and Accessible Learning), this office, through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD), in collaboration with the Education Support Services Division (ESSD), will carry out the Math Chronicles initiative from August to September 2025.
2. This effort is conducted through the ongoing partnership between Junior Achievement of the Philippines and Johnson & Johnson, driven by a shared goal to help Filipino learners recover foundational academic skills after the pandemic.
3. The sessions shall be conducted once a week for two hours. The Math Chronicles shall focus on strengthening key competencies in Grade 6 Mathematics, particularly in the following domains:
 - a) Number Algebra: GEMDAS, decimals, fractions, ratios, and proportions.
 - b) Geometry: angles, shapes, area, perimeter, and volume.
 - c) Data and Probability: data presentation, interpretation, single- and double-line graphs, and theoretical probability.
4. A total of 2,000 Grade 6 learners from public elementary schools across Region VIII will participate in the sessions. Accordingly, each Schools Division Office (SDO) is asked to identify and submit a list of 150 Grade 6 learners. The Leyte SDO will provide a list of 200 learners who will take part in the Math Chronicles intervention.
