



Dr. Luis Gatmaitan

r. Luis Gatmaitan is a physician and acclaimed author of over 70 children's books, including Sandosenang Sapatos, Si Duglit ang Dugong Makulit, and Ang Pambihirang Buhok ni Raquel. He pioneered health and medical storytelling for children through his popular series Mga Kuwento ni Tito Dok. A seven-time Palanca awardee and Hall of Fame inductee in 2005, his works have been translated into multiple languages and adapted into stage productions, such as Sandosenang Sapatos by Tanghalang Pilipino. He currently serves as Chairperson of the National Council for Children's Television, represents writers in the Philippine Board on Books for Young People (PBBY), and writes a column for Pinoy Peryodiko of The Manila Times. In 2017, he received the Gawad Pambansang Alagad ni Balagtas and became the first Filipino nominated for the prestigious Astrid Lindgren Memorial Award.
