This is to inform the field that BSP - Eastern Samar Council will be conducting the Advance Training Course for **Kawan Leaders** on **August 05-10, 2025**. For **Troop Leaders, Outfit Advisors and Leaders of Adult**, the said training will be held on **August 04-10, 2025**, at **YOCENCA, Naparaan, Salcedo Eastern Samar**.

1. The objectives of this training course are the following:

To enhance the competence of the Unit Leaders handling their Unit;
To provide them the necessary skills in carrying out the programs of scouting;
To define the activities and the practical skills involved in scouting programs.

2. Participants to this training are graduates of the Basic Training Course, currently registered with his/her unit, and physically fit with duly accomplished physical examination form.

3. The Registration (Training Fee) is **EIGHT THOUSAND PESOS ONLY (P8,000.00)** to cover the expenses for meals, snacks, handouts, t-shirt, materials/supplies and other administrative expenses related to the conduct of the said training. The registration will be charged against the MOOE Fund subject to the usual auditing and accounting rules and regulations. First meal will be dinner, which is going to be served a day before the start of each course.

4. Application forms must be duly accomplished with proper endorsement from the Council Scout Executive to be submitted to the BSP Regional Office.

5. Each Participant is requested to pay the reservation fee of **Two Thousand Pesos Only (P2,000.00)** to the BSP- Eastern Samar Council, which is transferrable, but not refundable, on or before **July 3, 2025** in order to give ample time to the council for the preparation of necessary materials needed during this training.

6. A registered teacher-participant will be given service credits pursuant to the DepEd Memo No. 76, s. 2012, while School Heads shall be granted Compensatory Time Off (CTO) as per Civil Service Commission (CSC) and Department of Budget Management (DBM) Joint Circular No. 2, s. 2004 on Non-Monetary Remuneration for Overtime Service Rendered or shall be given service credits as per DepEd Order No. 53, s. 2003 on Updated Guidelines on Grant of Service Credits to Teachers, whichever is applicable, for their participation on August 09, 2025 (Saturday) and August 10, 2025 (Sunday).

7. All participants are requested to wear their scouting uniform Type "A" short pants and polo as a sign that they are scouters on training and they should also **bring with them enough clothing, sleeping gears, tent and camping gears.**

8. Immediate and wide dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
