

# MECHANICS 2025 Regional SCIMATH Battle

#### I. DATES AND VENUES

#### II. ELIGIBILITY

- 1. The quiz show is open to bona fide **Grade 6** pupils of the current school year.
- 2. Each school is allowed to field only **one (1) team**, composed of two (2) members: **one (1) male** and **one (1) female**.
- 3. Each participating school shall have one official coach only. If the school has no coach, the privilege shall be given to the principal or any school representative.
- 4. The contestants must be in their school uniform and ID during the competition.

### III. GENERAL MECHANICS

- The quiz show shall have three rounds: Easy, Average, and Difficult.
  - a. There will be a total of 25 questions: 10 multiple-choice questions for the Easy and Average rounds and 5 identification and problem-solving questions for the Difficult round.
  - b. Each correct answer shall have a **corresponding point**: 1 point for Easy, 3 points for Average, and 5 points for Difficult.
  - c. Each question for each round must be answered within the time allocated for it: 10 seconds for Easy, 20 seconds for Average, and 30 seconds for Difficult.
  - d. The questions will cover the scope of the National Competitive Examination: Scientific Ability, Quantitative Ability, Abstract Reasoning, and Verbal Ability.

- 2. The top 3 teams with the highest points will be declared the winners for each stage of the quiz show.
- 3. However, only the top 1 team to emerge during the Regional Eliminations shall proceed and be the official representative of the region to the National Category.
  - a. In the event that 1 member or both members of the winning team from the Regional Eliminations is unavailable to compete during the National Finals, a replacement shall be taken from the next team in rank.
  - Travel-related expenses during the national contest will be covered by the PSHS - EVC and OED.

#### IV. QUIZ SHOW PROPER MECHANICS

- 1. Before the quiz show starts, each team will be provided with the following:
  - a whiteboard where they will write their answers using a marker; and
  - other writing materials (pens, scratch paper, and erasers) for solving/computations
- 2. The use of calculators or any computing devices is **NOT** allowed.
- 3. The quiz master shall read each question twice and the time for the team to answer shall start only after the quiz master says "Go." The teams, however, may start already doing their computations/solving while the quizmaster is still reading the question.
- 4. Before the time is up, the team must write its final answer on the whiteboard provided.
- If the team wishes to change its answer( the former answer should be erased/changed immediately, and the team must write the correct and final answer within the allotted time.
- 6. Late answers are not considered for points and will be regarded as 'No Answer'.
- 7. The quizmaster shall then read the correct answer before acknowledging whether a team gets the correct answer or not.
- 8. All answers must be formatted correctly to be considered correct. This means that:
  - a. All answers must be spelled, capitalized (if necessary), and punctuated/marked correctly.

- b. If the answer is numerical, it should follow the CORRECT significant figures rules.
- c. If the answer is a chemical formula, it should follow the IUPAC rules.
- d. If the answer is a scientific name, it should follow the CORRECT capitalizations.
- e. If the answer requires a unit, the SI units will be followed.
- f. In case of answers that may have alternate versions (e.g., The Pythagorean Theorem for the Pythagoras Theorem; International System of Units for SI Units or Systèm International d'unitès), only the Board of Judges may declare the acceptability or correctness of the answer.

# V. PROTESTS

- 1. The duly registered coach or official chaperone of the team is the only person authorized to file a protest.
- 2. Any protests should be referred to the Board of Judges before the quiz master proceeds to reading the next question.
- 3. No protests shall be entertained by the Board of Judges after the quizmaster starts reading the next question.
- 4. The decision of the Board of Judges once declared shall be final.

#### VI. AWARDS/PRIZES

1. The top 3 teams/winners in the Regional Eliminations of the competition shall receive the following prizes:


