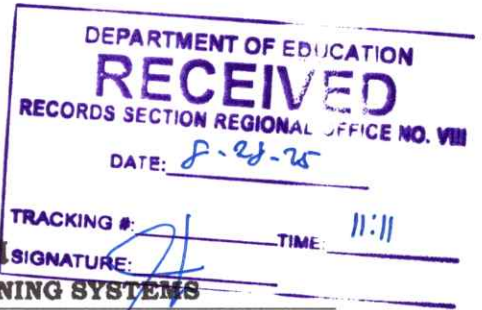

implementers with a comprehensive guide to effectively delivering ALIVE programs. This material ensures culturally, and pedagogically appropriate teaching methodologies, materials, and best practices aligned with Islamic principles and DepEd guidelines.

Specifically, the objectives of the writeshops are:

- A. To enhance the teaching competencies of Asatidz through continuous professional development, training, and mentorship programs.
- B. To provide culturally sensitive instructional materials tailored to diverse learning needs, considering different linguistic proficiency and cultural backgrounds of learners.
- C. To promote collaborative engagement among stakeholders, including parents, school, administrators, community leaders, and policy makers, in sustaining and improving ALIVE education.
- D. To uphold Islamic values while integrating modern educational approaches to create a balanced, inclusive, and high-quality learning experience.

Participants in these activities will include select Regional and Division Madrasah Education Program (MEP) coordinators (RMEPCs and DMEPCs), English/Reading supervisors/coordinators with experiences in developing learning materials, and ALIVE teachers (*Asatidz*) with strong communication skills and good understanding of the Arabic language. **See matrix of participants per activity in Annex A, and Program Matrix in Annex B.**

Board and lodging and travel expenses shall be charged against **2025 Madrasah Current Funds** subject to the usual government accounting and auditing procedures. All travel expenses have been downloaded to the respective regions of the participants. Should transportation expenses exceed the downloaded funds, remaining expenses shall be charged against any available local funds. Participants are expected to bring their own laptop, extension cord, and pocket Wi-Fi.


