Multigrade Teaching and Learning Resources	28-30, 2025	(within NCR)

This orientation is designed to develop the key persons of the Multigrade Program Support Funds (PSF) from mere resource administrators into strategic program leaders. The goal is to provide participants with the skills needed to effectively utilize the PSF in implementing











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multigrade teaching and learning resources in multigrade schools. By the end of this activity, participants will be able to:

- Identify their specific roles and responsibilities in the transparent management of Multigrade Program support funds, focusing on professional development for multigrade teachers and school heads, and the production of quality-assured teaching and learning materials aligned with the Revised K to 10 Curriculum.
- Equip participants with the knowledge and skills necessary for the effective utilization of multigrade teaching and learning resources, integrating of appropriate pedagogical approaches and assessment strategies to enhance multigrade instruction.
- 3. Develop a localized strategic plan for the effective and efficient utilization of Multigrade Program Support Funds in their respective regions and divisions.

In this regard, this Office would like to invite key program implementers, including regional and division MG Program focal persons, supervisors, and principals, to participate in the orientation. However, the accommodation costs for this preliminary day will be borne solely by local funds. Should the downloaded funds prove insufficient to fully cover all travel expenses, any remaining balance will likewise be supplemented by local funds.

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
