## ORIENTATION OF CORE TRAINERS ON REPUBLIC ACT NO. 11650 IMPLEMENTATION FOR LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT OFFICIALS

To: Schools Division Superintendents All Others Concerned

- In reference to Memorandum DM-LS-2025-135 dated October 7, 2025, issued by the Office of the Undersecretary for Learning Systems, all concerned are informed of the conduct of the Orientation of Core Trainers on the Implementation of Republic Act No. 11650 for Local Government Unit Officials on November 10-12, 2025, at the Great Eastern Hotel, Quezon Avenue, Quezon City.
- The activity aims to deepen the understanding and strengthen the implementation of the provisions of Republic Act No. 11650, otherwise known as "An Act Instituting a Policy of Inclusion and Services for Learners with Disabilities in Support of Inclusive Education, Establishing Inclusive Learning Resource Centers of Learners with Disabilities in All School Districts, Municipalities, and Cities, and Appropriating Funds Therefor." The Department of Education (DepEd), through the Learning Systems Strand, will conduct the Orientation of Core Trainers on Republic Act No. (RA) 11650 Implementation for Local Government Unit (LGU) Officials on November 10 to 12, 2025, in the National Capital Region. A separate advisory will be issued to announce the specific venue of the activity.

The said activity aims to:

- Equip core trainers with a comprehensive understanding of RA 11650, including its key provisions, mandates, and the critical role of LGUs in implementing inclusive education policies and programs;
- 2. Discuss common barriers to the implementation of inclusive education at the LGU level and explore practical solutions and best practices;
- 3. Strengthen partnerships between LGUs, volunteer groups, organizations, and agencies to support the effective implementation of RA 11650 and enhance inclusive education initiatives at the local level; and
- Conduct simulation activities to assess the core trainers' capacity to orient and educate LGU officials on RA 11650 and its implementation strategies effectively.

The orientation shall be attended by personnel from DepEd, LGUs, partner agencies, organizations, institutions, and other relevant stakeholders. In line with this, each Regional Office is requested to identify the following participants who will serve as part of the pool of core trainers on RA 11650 implementation for LGU officials:

If no representative is available from either office, the LGU may designate an official from another relevant office suited to the nature of the activity.

In addition, each region must submit an official list of participants, both from the SDOs and the LGUs, using the format provided in Enclosure No. 1 of this Memorandum.
