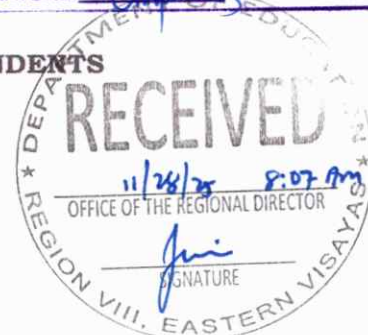

1. Pursuant to Department of Education (DepEd) Memorandum No. 84, s. 2025 titled "National Biotechnology Week 2025 Celebration," DepEd is pleased to announce the Official Results of the National Biotechnology Week (NBW) 2025 Event Categories. The NBW 2025 Celebration was held from 28 to 30 October 2025 at Century Park Hotel, Malate Manila, with the theme: *#gAIInBiotech: growing Artificial Intelligence, nurturing Biotechnology*.
2. The event was established through Presidential Proclamation No. 1414, s. 2007, and later amended by Presidential Proclamation No. 921, s. 2025, which moved the observance of National Biotechnology Week (NBW) from the fourth week of November to the fourth week of September each year to align with the Global Biotech Week celebration. The amendment also reconstituted the National Biotechnology Week Inter-Agency Steering Committee (IASC), which is now composed of the heads of eight government agencies: the Department of Education (DepEd), Department of Agriculture (DA), Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR), Department of Health (DOH), Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG), Department of Science and Technology (DOST), Department of Trade and Industry (DTI), and the Commission on Higher Education (CHED), with the Chairperson and Co-Chairperson rotating annually among them.
3. The NBW 2025 celebration served as an avenue to highlight advancements, innovations, and contributions of biotechnology in agriculture, healthcare, the

environment, and industry. The event also serves as a platform for collaboration among academia, government, industry, and the public to promote awareness and foster innovation. DepEd organized activities such as the Biotech Brain Triathlon, the Intercollegiate Biotech Brain Quest, and the Collaborative Digital Poster Making Contest for senior high school and college students.
