SAFER INTERNET DAY 2026

To: Schools Division Superintendents
All Others Concerned

- Attached is a communication from the Regional Inter-Agency Council Against Trafficking and Anti-Violence Against Women and Children (RCAT-VAWC), of which the Department of Education is an active member, requesting the participation of selected learners and their advisers in the observance of Safer Internet Day 2026 on February 10, 2026, in Catbalogan City. The exact venue shall be communicated through a separate Advisory.
- This year's observance is anchored on the theme: ***"Ikaw, Ako, Tayo: Konektado at Protektado Laban sa OSAEC at CSAEM.*** The activity aims to strengthen learners' awareness of online safety concerns while deliberately developing their critical thinking skills, particularly in navigating digital spaces and the ethical, responsible, and discerning use of Artificial Intelligence (AI). Through guided discussions and interactive activities, learners are expected to analyze online content, identify risks, and make informed decisions that protect themselves and others in an increasingly AI-driven digital environment.



- Catbalogan City Agro-Industrial School (CCAIS): 10 slots


Our goal is to guide the youth on the responsible use of AI and ensure they are aware of the referral mechanisms for child abuse and exploitation.
