The Department of Education (DepEd), through the Bureau of Curriculum Development - Special Curricular Programs Division, announces the **2026 Special Program in Foreign Language (SPFL)-Chinese Teachers' Summer Training** to be held from **May 4 to 30, 2026**, at the **Confucius Institute, Angeles University Foundation, Angeles City, Pampanga**.

Organized by the Confucius Institute at Angeles University Foundation (CI-AUF), the training provider and partner of this Department in the implementation of SPFL-Chinese, the said training aims to enhance the participants' Chinese language proficiency and provide valuable insights into Chinese language teaching and intercultural communication.



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In this regard, SPFL-Chinese teachers - Batch 13 and Master of Arts in Education major in Chinese Language Teaching (MAEd CLT) Batch 2024 and Batch 2025 students, who successfully completed their summer training last year, are eligible to participate in this training as part of the program's continuing professional development framework. Kindly refer to Appendix A for the list of participants.

The schedule of the activity ensures that classes will not be disrupted, in adherence to the provisions of DepEd Order No. 9, s. 2005 titled *Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time-On-Tasks and Ensuring Compliance Therewith* and DepEd OASGFO Memorandum No. 2022-058 with the subject *Request for the Participation of Learners and Teachers in Extra-Curricular Activities*.

The training fees, accommodation, and meals will be covered by the CI-AUF while the travel and incidental expenses shall be chargeable against School Maintenance and Other Operating Expenses (MOOE), Special Education Fund, other local funds, and/or Special Curricular Programs-Program Support Fund subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

Further, the participating teachers are eligible to avail of service credits commensurate to the number of hours/days of the training as scheduled, pursuant to DepEd Order No. 13, s. 2024 titled *Revised Guidelines on the Grant of Vacation Service Credits for Teachers*.

- c. designate mentor/supervisor to support and jointly implement the Re-Entry Action Plan/ Work Action Plan of the scholar (where applicable);
- d. monitor the implementation of the REAP/WAP.

DepEd Scholar shall:

- a. maintain the academic standards and other course requirements set for by the program of the institution and Department of Education (DepEd) and that failure to do so would be sufficient grounds for disqualification and termination of the scholarship;
- b. conduct himself/herself in such manner that will uphold the moral integrity and professionalism of DepEd public servant;
- c. return to official station and resume functions immediately upon the completion or termination of my scholarship or training grant;
- d. at the end of the scholarship or training grant, submit to the head of office and the Department of Education (DepEd) through the National Educators Academy of the Philippines (NEAP) a copy of the scholarship report containing lessons for the conduct of echo seminars to share new learnings, teaching innovations, and strategies to their co-teachers and administrators; various trainings, program highlights and general impressions constituting (scholar's) evaluation of the program;
- e. upon return to their station, implement the echo seminars and submit reports to the Professional Development Division, National Educators Academy of the Philippines at Second Floor, Mabini Building, DepEd Complex, Meralco Avenue, Pasig City;
- f. shall teach the subject / conduct echo seminars on the course in which they were granted the scholarship and continue to serve their school / division / region for at

least three years which is the service obligation equivalent for a year of scholarship or a fraction thereof;

- g. shall **refund in full** to the Department of Education such sums of money as may have been defrayed by the Philippine government for expenses incidental to my scholarship, for failure to comply with any of the foregoing conditions through my fault or willful neglect, resignation from the service, transfer to other agencies, voluntary retirement or other causes within my control. For reasons beyond the control of the scholar, the conditions do not apply, provided that all documentary requirements including doctor's certification are met and are acceptable to DepEd.
