**CONDUCT OF HYBRID LEARNING SYSTEM REFORM POLICIES ORIENTATION
FOR OTHER REGIONAL AND DIVISION OFFICE PERSONNEL,
SCHOOL HEADS, AND TEACHERS**

To: Schools Division Superintendents
All Others Concerned

1. In compliance with DepEd Memorandum DM-LS-2026-138 dated April 16, 2026, this Office, through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD) and the Leyte Division as the host, will conduct the Hybrid Orientation on the Learning System Reform Policies for the other Regional and Division Personnel, School Heads, and Teachers on May 4-5, 2026 at a venue to be announced later.
2. The activity aims to ascertain unified understanding among technical assistance providers and field implementers for successful implementation of the reform policies.
3. The orientation shall be conducted in hybrid modality. Attending the face-to-face modality are select participants from the Regional Office, Schools Division Offices, school heads, and teachers. Allocated number per position and per division is in Enclosures 1 and 2. For online modality through party viewing, the link using MS Teams shall be provided during the tech-run on May 3, 2026.
4. Each of the party viewing sites shall use the configuration account (*e.g. SDO_district_number_of_participants_position*). One account per SDO/district/group shall be accepted. There shall be a pre-registration of accounts by group by accomplishing the Google Sheet via <https://tinyurl.com/LSSReformOrientation>.
5. Each party viewing site must have back-up laptop and camera for the video feed, and technical booth set-up to ensure audio is properly synced online, and a dedicated internet connection for the main device.
6. There will be planning orientation to discuss necessary preparations with the Regional and Division Technical Working Groups on April 24, 2026, at 9:00-12:00 p.m. via Google Meet.
7. Expenses incurred in the conduct of this activity shall be charged against available local funds such as, but not limited to, Basic Education Curriculum (BEC)/ Human Resource Training and Development (HRTD) Funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

7. Immediate dissemination of and compliance with this Memorandum are desired.
