

BRIGADA ESKWELA KICK OFF**

The Department of Education (DepEd) continues to implement *Brigada Eskwela* as an annual initiative that mobilizes volunteers, partners, and community stakeholders to support public schools in preparing safe, clean, and conducive learning environments for learners.

Consistent with the DepEd Order No. 12, s. 2025 titled "Multi-year Implementing Guidelines on the School Calendar and Activities, the *Brigada Eskwela* Week will be conducted on June 1–5, 2026, in preparation for the opening of classes on June 8, 2026. The activity aims to strengthen community participation and collaboration to ensure that schools are ready to welcome learners at the start of the school year.

In preparation for the nationwide kick-off on **June 1, 2026**, all Regions are hereby requested to **identify one (1) host school within your respective areas to serve as the venue for the said activity.**

In identifying the host school, please give priority to those that require multiple forms of support—such as minor repairs, classroom enhancements, cleaning, painting, or other improvement initiatives. Selecting such schools will ensure that the combined efforts of partners, volunteers, and stakeholders create a tangible and meaningful impact, effectively preparing the school for the opening of classes, which remains the primary purpose of *Brigada Eskwela*.

Furthermore, similar to last year's implementation and in line with the signed Memorandum of Agreement with the Development Bank of the Philippines (DBP), financial assistance amounting to **Fifty Thousand Pesos (P50,000.00)** will be provided to each identified host school in support of the *Brigada Eskwela* activities.

Please note that, in accordance with the policy set forth in the MOA with DBP, the recipient of the financial assistance shall be an **elementary school**. Should a Region identify a secondary school as the host for the kick-off activity, kindly also designate an elementary school that will receive DBP's *Brigada Eskwela* financial assistance.
