Pursuant to Republic Act (RA) 11510, otherwise known as "An Act Institutionalizing the Alternative Learning System in Basic Education for Out-of-School Children in Special Cases and Adults and Appropriating Funds Therefor," the Department of Education, through the Bureau of Alternative Education (BAE), continues to strengthen mechanisms to ensure inclusive, accessible, and responsive learning opportunities for all.

In line with this mandate, the Enhanced ALS Mapping Tool shall be utilized to systematically identify, locate, and profile out-of-school children in special cases, youth, and adults (OSCYAs). The tool is likewise intended to generate reliable data to support evidence-based planning, strategic resource allocation, and effective program implementation.

In this regard, the Bureau shall conduct an online orientation for select Schools Division Offices (SDOs) on the proper use of the Enhanced ALS Mapping Tool. The activity aims to ensure a comprehensive understanding of the tool's features, adherence to standardized data collection procedures, and the accurate and timely reporting of mapping results.

The conduct of mapping using the said tool is expected to enhance the accuracy and efficiency of data collection, strengthen data-driven decision-making, and improve coordination among field offices and key stakeholders in identifying and reaching target learners, thereby expanding the delivery of education services.
