**MONITORING OF THE DELIVERY, DISTRIBUTION, AND UTILIZATION OF
CO-RO PROCURED LEARNING RESOURCES, SPECIAL CURRICULAR
PROGRAMS (SCPs), OTHER PROGRAMS AND PROJECTS,
CURRICULUM CONTEXTUALIZATION INCLUDING ALS,
FOR CALENDAR YEARS 2026-2027**

To: Schools Division Superintendents
All Others Concerned

1. Pursuant to the Department of Education's commitment to ensuring the effective implementation of curriculum programs and the efficient management of learning resources and support mechanisms, this Office shall conduct the **Monitoring of the Delivery, Distribution, and Utilization of CO-RO Procured Learning Resources, Special Curricular Programs (SCPs), Other Programs and Projects, Curriculum Contextualization for Learning Areas including the Alternative Learning System (ALS), and the Learning Resources Management and Development Process (LRMDP)** in all Schools Division Offices (SDOs) in Region VIII for Calendar Years 2026-2027.
2. The monitoring activity aims to:
 - a. assess the status of the delivery, distribution, utilization, inventory management, and reporting of learning resources provided to library hubs, schools, and learners;
 - b. validate the implementation and utilization of Kindergarten Learning Packages (KLPs), Textbooks (TXs), Teachers' Manuals (TMs), and other learning resources;
 - c. determine the extent of the implementation of Special Curricular Programs (SCPs), as well as other curriculum-related programs and projects;
 - d. assess the implementation of curriculum contextualization initiatives across learning areas, including the Alternative Learning System (ALS);
 - e. evaluate the status of the Learning Resources Management Information System (LRMIS) operations and the Learning Resources Management and Development Process (LRMDP);
 - f. identify implementation gaps, challenges, and areas for improvement, while documenting best practices; and
 - g. provide technical assistance and policy guidance to Schools Division Offices and schools to strengthen curriculum implementation and learning resource management.

3. The schedule of monitoring activities shall be agreed by the Regional Focal Person(s) and the concerned Schools Division Office counterparts, considering their availability and other operational requirements.
4. Expenses incurred in connection with this monitoring activity shall be charged against TBIMs/FLO-downloaded, local, and/or other SCP funds, subject to existing accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
5. Immediate dissemination of and compliance with this Memorandum are desired.
