**UNIFIED GRADE 12 SUBJECT OFFERINGS IN A THREE-TERM
FORMAT UNDER THE 2016 K TO 12 SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL
CURRICULUM FOR SCHOOL YEAR 2026-2027**

To: Schools Division Superintendents
All Others Concerned

1. In reference to DepEd Order No. 009, s. 2026 (Guidelines on the Implementation of the Three-Term School Calendar in Basic Education) and DepEd Order No. 017, s. 2026 (Strengthened Senior High School Curriculum), this Office, through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD), hereby informs all Senior High School implementing schools of the **Unified Grade 12 Subject Offerings in a Three-Term Format under the 2016 K to 12 Senior High School Curriculum for School Year 2026-2027**.
2. Pursuant to DO No. 017, s. 2026, schools must distribute Grade 12 subjects under the K to 12 SHS curriculum across three terms instead of two semesters. The purpose of the unified subject offerings for Grade 12 is to ensure continuity of learning and to support learners who may need to transfer or continue their studies in other schools within the region due to valid and unavoidable circumstances.
3. For School Year 2026-2027, Grade 11 shall fully implement the Strengthened Senior High School (SSHS) Curriculum, while Grade 12 shall undergo its final year of implementation under the K to 12 SHS Curriculum.
4. Private Senior High Schools (SHSs), as well as Local Universities and Colleges (LUCs) and State Universities and Colleges (SUCs) offering SHS, are highly encouraged to adopt the three-term calendar. However, they may opt to retain a two-semester calendar, provided that all prescribed instructional hours are strictly complied with.
5. The prescribed number of instructional hours and sample class programs, as provided in DepEd Order No. 009 and DepEd Order No. 017, s. 2026, may be adopted, provided that all required hours are fully complied with under the three-term calendar.
6. The unified subject offerings in a three-term format are attached for guidance and reference.



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7. Immediate dissemination of and compliance with this Memorandum are desired.

Note: The school may adopt DO 17 for sample class programming or use its own method of computation, provided that the required number of hours for the subject is met. The subjects may be delivered over four days at 1.5 hours per day, with the remaining hours allotted to asynchronous activities to complete the required number of hours. Alternatively, they may be delivered over five days per week until the required number of hours is completed. While Physical Education has only 40 hours, it may be delivered at 1 hour per day for 40 days, or the number of days within the block may be distributed across the 40 required hours to determine the hours per day.
