9. The SPRIX personnel shall conduct an on-site visit to the participating schools on June 9, 2026, to coordinate with their respective School Heads regarding the conduct of the survey and other related activities.
10. The visit shall be undertaken in coordination with the Regional Education Program Supervisor in Mathematics, the Regional Partnership Coordinator, and the Division Mathematics Supervisors of the Leyte and Tacloban City Divisions.

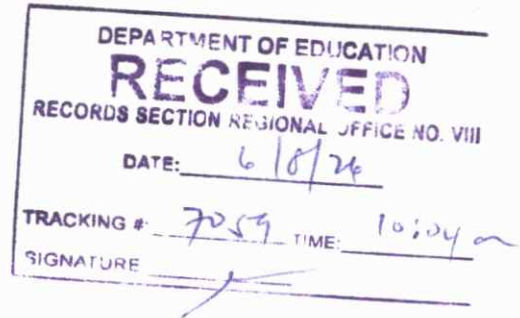
