IMPLEMENTATION OF THE COACH DEVELOPER ACADEMY

In line with the continuing partnership between the Department of Education (DepEd) and the Philippine Sports Commission (PSC) under the Grassroots to Gold Program, this Office informs all concerned of the invitation from the Philippine Sports Institute (PSI) to participate in the pilot implementation of the **Coach Developer Academy (CDA)**, a key component of the **National Sport Coaches Certification Program (NSCCP)**.

The CDA is designed to develop a national pool of Coach Developers who will support the professional learning and advancement of coaches across schools, regions, local government units, sports organizations, and community-based sports programs. The program seeks to strengthen coach education by preparing individuals who can facilitate learning, mentor coaches, provide feedback on coaching practice, support competency-based assessment, and contribute to the continuous improvement of coaching standards in the country.

For this pilot implementation, each Regional Office is requested to nominate **two (2) teacher-coaches** who are actively involved in *Palarong Pambansa* sports events and demonstrate strong potential in facilitation, mentoring, and leadership in coach education.

Nominees should meet the following qualifications:

1. Have at least five (5) years of teaching and/or coaching experience;
2. Demonstrate strong potential in facilitation, mentoring, reflective practice, ethical conduct, communication, and the ability to support the learning and development of fellow coaches;
3. Be endorsed by the Regional Director or an authorized DepEd official;
4. Preferably possess experience or familiarity with curriculum development and teaching-learning methodologies;

5. Preferably have knowledge of or experience with the International Council for Coaching Excellence (ICCE) framework or similar coaching development frameworks;
6. Be willing to travel to various locations for training and coach development activities, as may be required; and
7. Have no pending civil, criminal, or administrative cases.

The **Coach Developer Academy** will be conducted from **29 June to 3 July 2026** at the **Philsports Complex, Pasig City**. Detailed information regarding the program schedule, modules, and participant requirements shall be provided to confirmed participants.

As part of PSC's support under the Grassroots to Gold partnership, all training-related expenses of selected participants shall be covered, including round-trip transportation or airfare, accommodation, meals, and local transportation for the duration of the training.

To formalize the nomination, each identified coach-teacher shall:

1. Accomplish the online Coach Developer Academy Nominee Registration Form through the following link:

2. Upload the following documentary requirements through the same online registration platform on or before **June 19, 2026**:
 - o Brief Curriculum Vitae;
 - o Endorsement Letter signed by the Regional Director or authorized official; and
 - o Copies of relevant certificates and supporting documents related to the nominee's teaching and coaching background.

For monitoring and coordination purposes, Regional Offices are requested to ensure that only **two (2) eligible nominees per region** complete the online registration process for this pilot batch. All nominations and supporting documents shall be received and consolidated through the online system.

Participation in this initiative will contribute significantly to strengthening the capacity of DepEd coach-teachers and establishing a pool of accredited Coach Developers who will support the delivery of NSCCP-aligned coach education programs nationwide, thereby advancing a more coherent and sustainable pathway from grassroots school sports to high-performance athletic development.
