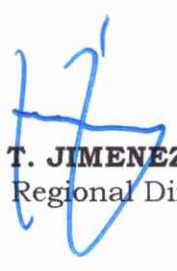
**UPDATES ON THE CONDUCT OF MONITORING FOR THE 2026 QUARTERLY
SCHOOLS DIVISION OFFICES (SDOs) PROGRAM IMPLEMENTATION
REVIEW (PIR) VALIDATION PROCESS**

To: Schools Division Superintendents
Regional Office Division Chiefs
All Others Concerned

1. In line with the Regional Memorandum No. 824, s. 2026, titled "Monitoring of the 2026 Quarterly SDOs PIR Validation Process," this Office hereby announces the following updates relative thereto:

- a) New set of RO monitors, as per attached list, will be deployed with three (3) members to facilitate faster and efficient data validation process;
- b) If the SDO PIR has been conducted, the RO monitors will coordinate with the SDO, through the Division M&E Coordinator, of possible schedule for monitoring and data-cum-MOVs validation at the respective offices;
- c) The SDO PIR Accomplishment Report, as generated from the Program Management Information System (PMIS), per Work and Financial Plan (WFP) will be used and necessary Remarks will be noted, especially those with no or lacking MOVs;
- d) The WFPs in the PMIS must have an accomplishment report and the primary rule of data validation is that outputs not supported by MOVs cannot be credited;
- e) The MOVs not present during the SDO PIR could be presented during the Regional PIR or on the next quarter's PIR;
- f) The RO Monitors will consolidate the result of the validated SDO PIR Accomplishment Report from all WFPs and offices, which will be an input for the Regional Performance Validation Team's (RPVT) activity on performance review;
- g) The RO Monitors will map the results vis-à-vis the Key Results Areas and Objectives in the SDO OPCR and input the same in the RPVT Tool to be readily used by the Performance Management Team; and
- h) The Quality Assurance Division will consolidate and analyze result from the monitoring reports for continuous improvement process.

2. All other provisions stipulated in the above Memorandum shall remain in force and in effect.
3. Immediate dissemination of and compliance with this Memorandum are desired.
