- As part of this Region's commitment to continuous quality improvement and to ensuring operational efficiency in the delivery of key learner-centered programs, this Office, through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD), shall conduct the **Post-Evaluation Conference on the 2026 NFOT-RFOT and NSPC-RSPC** on **August 12-13, 2026** at a venue to be announced through a subsequent advisory.
- The activity aims to achieve the following objectives:
 - assess and review the implementation of the 2026 NFOT-RFOT and NSPC-RSPC by identifying best practices, major bottlenecks, and critical areas of concern across all working committees;
 - analyze the financial, logistical, and technical management of the host division and the regional management team;
 - evaluate the performances and feedback of the delegation participants (learners, coaches, and working committees); and
 - formulate strategic recommendations and initial action steps ("Ways Forward") in preparation for the subsequent Regional and National level events.

The meal provisions for the two-day activity shall commence on Day 1 (August 12, 2026) with the morning snack and shall include afternoon snack and two (2) full meals (lunch and dinner), and shall conclude on Day 2 (August 13, 2026) with two (2) snacks (morning and afternoon) and two (2) full meals (breakfast and lunch), with the afternoon snack serving as the final meal provision and officially marking the conclusion of the activity.

Meals, board, and lodging of the participants shall be charged against the **2026 Program Support Funds (PSF)** of the **Campus Journalism** with **OSEC-8-26-01167** and **CLMD Local Funds**, whereas travel and other incidental expenses of the participants shall be charged against their respective local/division/school MOOE or other eligible source of funds, all subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
