BATCH 3 eACADEMY IMPLEMENTING SCHOOLS

1. In line with the Department's continuing commitment to strengthen instructional delivery and expand opportunities for learners, this Office, in collaboration with the Town4Kids of Singapore, announces the next set of public elementary and secondary schools that will benefit from the eAcademy Program starting August 2026. This initiative underscores the shared vision of empowering teachers with innovative tools while ensuring that quality education remains within reach of every child.

2. For this succeeding batch of implementers, a total of one hundred twenty-three (123) public elementary and high schools across the Region have been identified to participate in the program. These schools, enumerated in the table below, shall serve as partner institutions in the integration of the eAcademy, thereby ensuring wider access to digital learning resources and sustained support for teachers in enhancing classroom instruction.

3. As a recipient of the program, each school shall have free access to and enjoy the following benefits:

- High-quality blended learning software (eAcademy app) that can be used in different learning environments;
- Interactive and contextualized learning resources that support classroom instruction;
- Leveled reading texts that are ideal for supporting remediation activities such as ARAL sessions; and
- International seminars and activities for both teachers and learners.

4. To gain access to the eAcademy app, each school is required to accomplish the following:

- Identify one teacher-coordinator for the program;
- Fill out the School Implementation Form at <https://forms.gle/3CEDx7KMfNPUEgvz6>; and
- Attend the virtual school orientation.

5. As part of the onboarding process of the new schools, the **Division eAcademy Supervisors or Focal Persons, School Heads, and Teacher-Coordinators** are directed to attend a virtual orientation at 4:00 p.m. on July 31, 2026, Friday via Zoom link: <https://us02web.zoom.us/j/82608338187?pwd=dEaYb6R4PL6DeWHaCP9DBsw4bBIUKC.1>.

6. Teacher-coordinators with ongoing classes at the beginning of the meeting may join afterwards, since the orientation will continue until 6:00 p.m.
