Its main purpose is to teach the learners about the love of God and share with them this love through the Book of Hope.

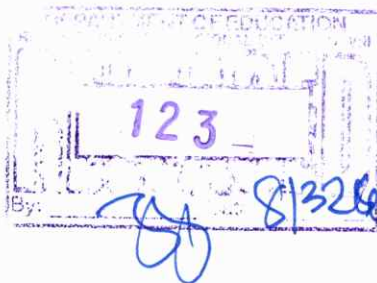

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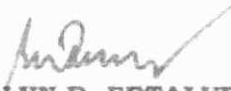
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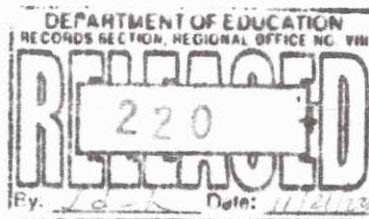
